SOCIAL SERVICES FOR OLDER PEOPLE IN SPAIN. JANUARY 2006

The data presented in this chapter refer to the public and private social service network for older people in Spain on 1st January 2006.

The Observatory of Older People prepares annual social service indicators for older people in Spain. A homogeneous series by autonomous community is currently available which covers the 1999-2006 period.

In the 2000, 2002 and 2004 reports *Las Personas Mayores en España* the indicators for 1999, 2000, 2001 and 2004 are included. The data relating to January 2002 and January 2005 are published in the Bulletin on ageing *Perfiles y Tendencias* numbers 8 (June 2003) and 22 (April 2006) respectively, which are edited by the Observatory of Older People itself. All of these documents are also available on the Portal Mayores Web page (<http://www.imsersomayores.csic.es>).

The indicators are of a quantitative nature and refer to the following variables: number of users of social services, user profile, number of places and distribution by ownership and funding, coverage rates, unit prices and funding, and assigned budget, or in its absence, estimated expenditure. The indicators are prepared by type of service for each autonomous community and from the total or average, depending on the indicator, the national level indicators are obtained.

Social services include: home care services (home help, teleassistance, meals services, technical aids, family support, ...), day care services (clubs -hogares y clubes in Spanish- and day centres for dependent older people), and residential care services (residential centres, temporary stays, sheltered housing, apartments and foster care for older people).

In the context of the important reform that the implementation of the National System for Dependency in Spain represents, which began with the publication of the *Libro Blanco sobre atención de personas en situación de dependencia*, new features have been introduced in this edition: information is collected in relation to the number of users who are dependent in all of the services, and there is more information on home care services, including on technical aids for personal autonomy, family support programmes and programmes for dependency. Finally, the variable average age of admission to a residential centre by sex, is included.

The sources employed for analysing data and preparing indicators are as follows: the 2000, 2002 and 2004 reports *Las Personas Mayores en España* (Ministry of Labour and Social Affairs-IMSERSO); Base de datos de Residencias de Portal Mayores; *Libro Blanco sobre atención de personas en situación de dependencia en España* (January 2005) (<http://www.imsersomayores.csic.es>); National Statistics Office (www.Ine.es), *Datos de Población, Padrón Municipal* (various years); *Cuentas Económicas, Contabilidad Regional de España*; records submitted by the autonomous communities,

Basque provincial governments (Diputaciones Forales in Spanish) and autonomous cities of Ceuta and Melilla on social services for older people in January 2006.

The Observatory of Older People would like to thank the autonomous communities and local entities for their collaboration in providing information, which was essential for the preparation of the indicators, as well as for the suggestions made in order to gradually improve the information.

1. SOCIAL SERVICES FOR OLDER PEOPLE IN SPAIN. GENERAL DATA. JANUARY 2006

The population aged 65 years and over in Spain on 1st January 2006 represented 16.8% of the total population, with 7,477,761 people aged 65 years and over.

The social services available for this older group and to which we are going to refer are: public home care services (home help services -SAD in the Spanish acronym-, teleassistance and other services), public and private day care services (clubs for older people and day centres for dependent older people) and public and private residential care services.

The people in receipt of home care services are distributed as follows: 305,801 correspond to SAD, 261,433 to teleassistance and 67,839 people aged 65 years and over benefited from another type of home care service (meals or laundry service) or received some financial assistance related to home care (home adaptation, family support, technical aids). In all, 8.5% of the population aged 65 years and over use home care services.

Day care services include clubs for older people, with a total of 3,525,499 members, and day centres for dependent people, with 47,624 private and public places available on 1st January 2006.

There are 308,021 public and private places available in residential care, of which 97% (298,870) are places in residential centres and the remaining 9,151 places are available in alternative accommodation systems (sheltered housing mainly, foster care and residential apartments). More than 4% of the population aged 65 years and over use residential care services on 1st January 2006. The number of residential places for dependent people was 156,973 and the number of temporary stay places in residential homes was 3,068.

The average unit price in January 2006 for the SAD service is 191.64 euros per month (12.12 euros/hour); for the public teleassistance service it is 21.79 euros per month. The public price of a place for a dependent person in a day centre is approximately 600 euros per month and for a residential place for a non-dependent person, it is 1,317.54 euros per month.

The distribution of the users of the social services targeted in this study, by sex and age, show that there is a predominance of women users in all of the services. This predominance is more pronounced in the home care service, with approximately 73% of users of this service being women. A total of 53% of users of clubs are women and 67% of users of day centres and residential centres are women.

Social service users tend to be in the more advanced age groups, and in half or more of the cases, depending on the type of service, they are aged 80 years and over. In the case of clubs the average age drops to 72 years. The age of admission to residential centres is approximately 81 years; for men it is somewhat lower.

2. HOME CARE SERVICES

Home care services for older people include home help service (SAD), the teleassistance service and other resources which can be considered as home care and are rendered as a service (such as domiciliary meal service or laundry service), as well as financial benefits of a public nature (assistance for home help, home adaptations, aids to family carers and technical aids).

With regard to the public or private nature of these services, it is worth mentioning that the data presented below refer to the services offered in the public sector (with public contributions in their funding) and managed, mostly, by entities of a private nature under the system of special agreements with the administration (sistema de concertación in Spanish).

2.1. PUBLIC HOME HELP SERVICE (SAD)

The number of people in receipt of the SAD service in January 2006 was 305,801 people aged 65 years and over. Madrid, with 54,631 users, is the autonomous community with the highest number of users. Other communities with a high number of SAD users are: Cataluña (47,866), Andalucía (38,229) and Castilla-La Mancha and Castilla y León, each with more than 23,000 users.

The coverage rate at national level, defined as the percentage of people aged 65 years and over who are users of the service, is situated at an average of 4.09. Extremadura is the community with the highest coverage rate, with 9.82, almost six points above the national average. Castilla-La Mancha and Madrid also stand out, with coverage rates of 6.37 and 6.29, respectively.

The hourly intensity, defined as the number of hours of attention per user per month, is situated at an average of 16.28 hours/month/user, of which an average of 5.97 hours/month are devoted to the personal care of the user and 10.31 to domestic tasks. However, this distribution is not the same for all of the autonomous communities. In seven of the fifteen communities which provide information on this indicator, the time devoted to the personal care of the beneficiary is greater or much greater than the time devoted to domestic tasks. This is the case in Asturias (52%), Baleares (84), Cataluña (73), Madrid (53), Navarra (54), País Vasco (70) and La Rioja (51). The profile of the distribution of time in home care has changed throughout the 1999-2006 period, with a progressive increase in the number of communities in which more time is devoted to the personal care of the older person than to domestic tasks.

With regard to the profile of the users of the SAD service, by sex and age, there are more women users, with percentages ranging between 53% in País Vasco and 95 in Castilla-La Mancha. In almost all of the autonomous communities, the majority of users are aged 80 years and over.

The public price of the SAD service is situated at a national average of 12.12 euros/hour/user. There are important fluctuations between communities, most notably Navarra and Melilla, with a price of 22.32 and 20.09 euros/hour, respectively. Extremadura and Cantabria are the communities with the lowest public price: 6.18 and 7.30 euros/hour, respectively.

The number of users has substantially increased between January 1999 and January 2006; an increase of 193,004. This increase is reflected in the coverage rate which is 2.4 percentage points higher than in 1999, and is situated at 4% of the older population in January 2006.

2.2. PUBLIC TELEASSISTANCE SERVICES

The public teleassistance service is used by 3.5 of every 100 people aged 65 years and over, according to the January 2006 data. The total number of people in receipt of this service was 261,433. Once again, Madrid is the autonomous community with the highest number of users of this resource, with 31% of the total (80,024). Andalucía has 41,174 and at a greater distance, Castilla-La Mancha can be found with 20,826 users. The community of Valencia has 22,508, Castilla y León has 17,143, and Cataluña and País Vasco have 15,040 and 12,815 users, respectively.

The national coverage rate is situated at 3.5 users per 100 people aged 65 years and over, with Madrid (9.22), Castilla-La Mancha (5.74) and Navarra (5.22) having rates which are much higher than the national average. Canarias, Cataluña, Galicia and La Rioja can be found among the autonomous communities with the lowest coverage rates, around 1% or slightly higher.

The user profile is characterised by a majority of women, between 57 and 89%, depending on the community. We see greater differences between the autonomous communities with regard to age: for example, the proportion of users aged 80 years and over is much lower in communities such as Aragón (28%), Ceuta (26) or Melilla (36), while in others, the users aged over 80 years represent 70% or more, as is the case in Asturias (72%), Baleares (68) and La Rioja (79).

The public price per user is situated at a national average of 261.51 euros/year. The price in La Rioja (452.5 euros/year), Cataluña (320.6) and the community of Valencia (315 euros/year) is above the national average.

Between 1999 and 2006 the number of users of the public teleassistance service increased by 212,859 and the coverage rate increased by almost three percentage points.

2.3. OTHER HOME CARE SERVICES

The information available on other home care service is scarce. However, the most frequently used ones are the public domiciliary meal service and the financial assistance for home adaptations, the average amount of which ranges between 786.9 euros per year per user in the case of Melilla and 5,020 in Cataluña.

3. PUBLIC AND PRIVATE DAY CARE SERVICES

Day care services include clubs for older people and day centres for dependent older people, also known as day stays in some autonomous communities.

3.1. CLUBS FOR OLDER PEOPLE

There are 3,988 centres in Spain in January 2005, with 3,525,499 members aged 65 years and over. This figure represents 47.15% of the population aged 65 years and over. It is important to note that the calculation of number of users (members) of this resource is not homogeneous due to the complexity, in some cases, of obtaining information on the number of members of private centres or on the numbers relating to local entities. Therefore, the information on users of this service should be treated with caution. The communities which register the highest number of members are Andalucía (606,033) and Madrid (531,162), with coverage rates which exceed 50%. Other communities with high coverage rates are: Navarra (93.62%), Ceuta (93.16), La Rioja (89.8) and Baleares (81.62).

On the other hand, the communities with the lowest coverage rates are: Canarias (14.48%) and Cataluña (15.86). In the case of Cataluña, the low rates are due to the difference in methodological procedures; members of local entities or private centres are not included.

3.2. DAY CENTRES FOR DEPENDENT OLDER PEOPLE

In January 2006 there were 47,624 places distributed between 1,872 publicly and privately owned centres. Private ownership carries the most weight in terms of centres (62%) and places available (64% of the places are privately owned). With regard to the funding of the places, public sector participation is the most important: 60 of every 100 places receive public funding, of which 36 in turn are managed by the public sector and 24 by the private sector under the system of special agreements. The rest, 40 of every 100, are places which are entirely financed by the user at market prices and are managed by private entities.

The public price of a place for a dependent person in a day centre is situated at a national average of just over 7,000 euros per year. In the different autonomous communities, it ranges between 14,600 euros per year per place in País Vasco, 11,000 in Madrid and over 6,000 euros per year per place in communities like Asturias, Baleares, Castilla–La Mancha, Cataluña, Galicia and Navarra.

With regard to the price in private facilities under the system of special agreements, the information available for autonomous communities is insufficient to find a national average price. The communities with the highest annual price under the special agreement system are País Vasco (13,464.47 euros/year place) and Madrid (9,344.4). Murcia is the community with the lowest price under this system (4,273.19 euros/year place).

The information available in relation to the psychogeriatric places on offer and on the price of these places is very limited. In some communities such as Aragón, Cantabria, La Rioja or Ceuta, all of the places in day centres are classified as psychogeriatric. As regards the price of a psychogeriatric place under the special agreement system, it is only in Aragón that a significant difference (11,989 euros/year) is appreciated compared to a place for a dependent person under the special agreement system (7,980 euros/year).

As with the other resources, the user profile is characterised by a predominance of women users, although the proportion varies considerably from one community to another, and is situated between 54 and 78%. The differences between autonomous communities are even greater if we consider the proportion of users aged 80 years and over. In seven of the twelve communities which provided information, the majority of the users of this resource are aged 80 years and over and the percentage ranges between 52% in Melilla and 80 in Asturias. The average age of a day centre user is 80 years.

The evolution of day centres for dependent older people throughout the period 1999-2006 has been very dynamic. Between January 2000 and January 2006, there has been an annual increase of more than 7,000 new places, reaching 47,624 places in January 2006.

4. PUBLIC AND PRIVATE RESIDENTIAL CARE SERVICES

Residential care for older people includes the following resources: residential centres, public temporary stay services and alternative accommodation systems: sheltered housing, public foster care services, residential apartments and any other resource of a residential nature.

4.1. RESIDENTIAL CENTRES

The total number of residential places in January 2006 was 298,870, distributed between 6,052 centres. This figure represents an increase of 15,736 places and 923 centres compared to January 2005.

A total of 83% of residential centres (4,993) are privately owned and these centres manage 76% of the residential places available (225,882). Twenty per cent of the residential places (58,905) are managed through the system of special agreements with

the public sector and 56% (166,977) are places which are privately financed at market prices.

Seventeen per cent of the remaining centres (1,059) are publicly owned (managed) and provide 72,988 residential places (24% of all places). In terms of funding, 56% of residential places are offered at market prices and 44% receive public funding.

Although the structure outlined above is the structure in the majority of autonomous communities, the following points are worth highlighting: in Extremadura, residential care is predominantly in the public sector, both in terms of the number of publicly owned centres (65.2% of the total) and the number of places which receive public funding, 54%, compared to 46% for privately funded places. Likewise, in the community of Valencia, País Vasco, Ceuta and Melilla there are more places on offer which receive public funding than places which are privately funded.

Another feature of the Spanish residential care model is that the majority of residential centres (84%) have less than 100 places. To be more precise, 58% of centres have less than 50 places per centre, 26% have between 50 and 100, 9% have between 100 and 150 and only 7% have more than 150 residential places per centre.

The coverage rate for residential places is situated at a national average of 4% of the population aged 65 years and over.

Almost all of the autonomous communities provide information relating to user profile. Approximately 67% are women users and the majority (64%) are aged 80 years and over. In the case of women, 78% are aged over 80 years. The average age of residential centre users is 82 years, with an average age of admission to a residential home of 83 years for women and a little lower in the case of men, at 78 years.

The public price of a residential place is situated at an average of just over 15,800 euros per year per place (43 euros/day). The autonomous communities with a price which is much higher than the average are: País Vasco (32,400 euros/year place) and Madrid (24,757). On the other hand, in Aragón, Castilla y León and Navarra the price is much lower than the national average: between 6,800 and 8,600 euros/year per place.

Throughout the 1999-2006 period, there has been a year-on-year increase of more than 14,000 places in residential care, with 99,812 more places on offer between 1999 and 2006 and 2,332 new centres.

As regards the distribution of places, there has been an increase in the participation of places which belong to the system of special agreements; these places have increased by 6.5 percentage points at the expense of a reduction in the participation of private places (managed and funded privately) of 5 percentage points and to a lesser extent, in public places which have reduced 1.5 percentage points.

Places for dependent people and psychogeriatric places in residential centres

The number of places on offer in residential centres in January 2006 for dependent older people was 156,973. With regard to distribution between the public sector, the system of special agreements and the private sector, the autonomous communities can be divided into three groups. The first group is made up of the autonomous communities in which the majority of places for dependent people are in the public sector, as is the case in Asturias, Canarias, Extremadura, Galicia and Madrid.

The second group includes the communities in which the majority of places for dependent people belong to the system of special agreements with the public sector, as is the case in Andalucía, Cantabria, the community of Valencia, La Rioja and País Vasco. Finally, in Castilla y León, Cataluña and Navarra, it is in the private sector that there are more places for dependent people, particularly in Cataluña where there are 25,157 places for dependent people in the private sector. The information on the number of private places for dependent people is very limited, which means that this distribution could be very different if more information was available.

The average price of a residential place for a dependent person in the system of special agreements with the public sector is 16,311 euros per year (45 euros/day).

With regard to psychogeriatric places, the communities which have a higher number on offer are Cataluña and Galicia, with 8,842 and 5,265 places respectively, followed by the community of Valencia (2,674) and Extremadura (1,801). The average price of a psychogeriatric residential place in the system of special agreements is 17,815 euros per year (49 euros/day). In Andalucía, Cataluña, País Vasco and La Rioja the price in this system of special agreements is higher than the average, ranging between 20,300 and 27,300 euros per year per place. Extremadura is the community with the lowest price for psychogeriatric places in the system of special agreements, at approximately 33 euros/day.

Twelve of the nineteen autonomous communities provide information on the number of dependent users in residential centres. The total number of dependent users in residential centres is 59,738. On a national basis, this figure represents 61.6% of all users in residential centres, although the differences between autonomous communities are important. In Andalucía, Asturias, the community of Valencia and Melilla, dependent users are an important majority, representing between 72 and 86% of all residential centre users. In other communities such as Aragón, Castilla y León, Galicia and País Vasco, they represent approximately 69%, and in autonomous communities such as Baleares, Castilla-La Mancha or Murcia they do not even represent 50%.

These differences can be partly explained by the different criteria which currently exist in the autonomous communities for evaluating dependency. The implementation of the National System for Dependency will involve the application of standard criteria for the evaluation of dependency in the whole country, thus correcting the differences which can be explained by this cause.

4.2. TEMPORARY STAYS IN RESIDENTIAL CENTRES

The temporary stay in residential centre service can be defined as an intermediate resource for assisting, during short periods of time, dependent older people who normally live in their own homes¹. This resource caters for older people, offering a temporary care service at times of illness, crisis situations, or convalescence after an illness or accident, as well as for family carers as a respite service during holidays.

The information available on the temporary stay service is very limited and scarce, and as a result, we cannot prepare national indicators which are representative. However, the number of autonomous communities providing the necessary information is increasing. The autonomous communities offering the highest number of places are: Castilla-La Mancha (1,098), País Vasco (537), Andalucía (498), Madrid (400) and the community of Valencia (241).

4.3. ALTERNATIVE ACCOMMODATION SYSTEMS

In this section, and still under the heading residential services, we include accommodation for older people in sheltered housing, foster care or residential apartments. These alternative residential arrangements or any others with similar characteristics, have an advantage over being admitted to a residential centre, in that they allow the older person to stay in a more familiar environment, and in some cases, in their usual physical setting, with the availability of certain services, help and infrastructures, appropriate for older people.

The information available to date is very limited due to, among other reasons, the differences in how these resources are developed in the autonomous communities. This means that we cannot evaluate the scale and characteristics of the alternative accommodation systems on a national basis.

We focus on the sheltered housing service, for which we have information from fourteen autonomous communities relating to the number of housing schemes and places. In January 2006 there were 824 sheltered housing schemes with a total of 6,922 places available. Castilla-La Mancha and Cataluña are the communities with the highest number of places available. The price of a place in a sheltered housing scheme ranges between 16,743.18 euros per year (45.87 euros/day) in the case of País Vasco and 2,157 euros per year in Castilla-La Mancha.

5. INDICATORS FOR PUBLIC EXPENDITURE ON SOCIAL SERVICES FOR OLDER PEOPLE

The indicators for public expenditure on social services for older people have been prepared using the budgetary information provided by the autonomous communities. For those communities for which information on the assigned budget has not been made available (Andalucía, Aragón, Baleares, Cantabria, Madrid, Murcia and Ceuta), expenditure on 1st January 2006 was estimated. To do this, the unit prices of the different services and the corresponding consumption units (users or places) were

calculated using the information provided by the autonomous communities. The estimated overall expenditure figure is the sum total of the estimated expenditure on each of the social services considered.

Given that this delimitation refers to public expenditure, resources funded by the public sector have been considered, in other words, those which come directly under the public sector as well as those included in the system of special agreements with the public sector.

Using the budgetary or estimated public expenditure figure, two basic expenditure indicators are calculated: expenditure per person aged 65 years and over and expenditure with respect to Gross Domestic Product (GDP).

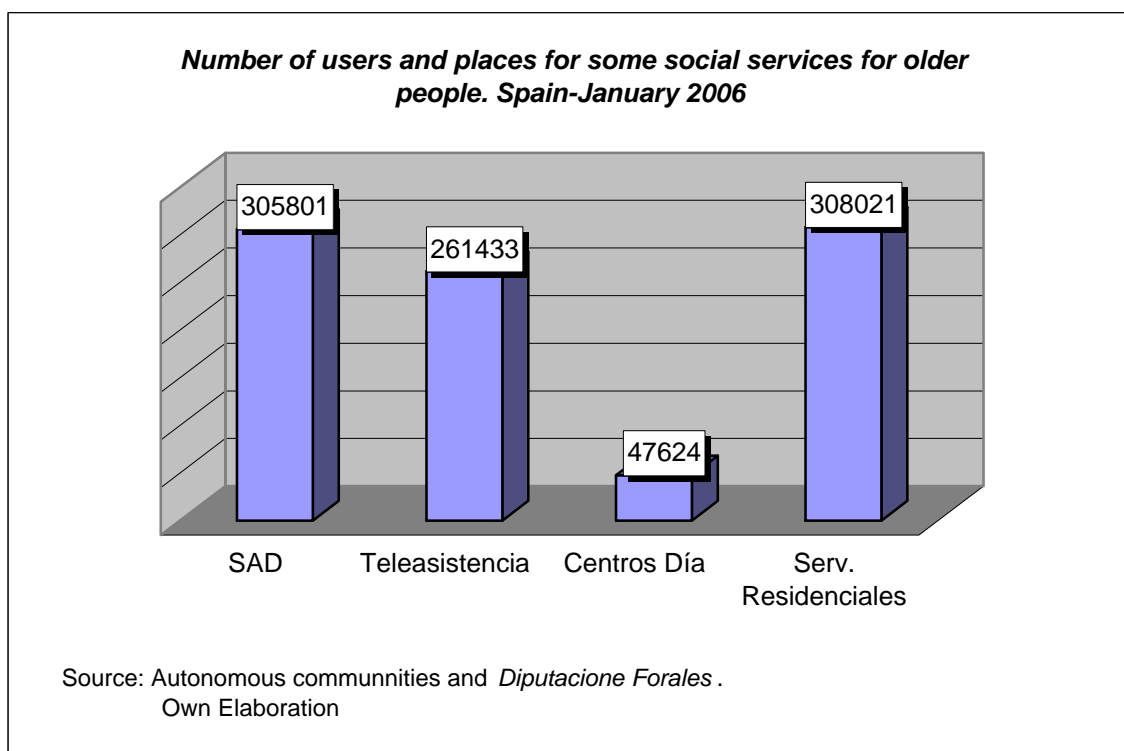
Public expenditure on social services for older people amounts to 2,866.5 million euros on the 1st January 2006. In terms of GDP, at national level, it represents 0.32 %. The communities which make a greater effort, measured using the expenditure/GDP relationship, are Castilla-La Mancha (0.77%), La Rioja (0.56) and Asturias (0.51), all of which are communities with an ageing population structure. Aragón, Galicia and Cataluña are situated around the average (0.29-0.26% of GDP) and Canarias comes last with a weight of expenditure in terms of GDP of 0.11%.

If we consider the expenditure per person aged 65 years and over, it would signify an expenditure of 383.34 euros per person per year at national level. The communities which easily exceed this amount are: Madrid (702.29 €), and País Vasco, Castilla-La Mancha and La Rioja, with an average amount of over 650 euros per person aged 65 years and over. Canarias is situated at the other end of the scale with expenditure per person aged 65 years and over of 168.91 euros per year.

NOTE: Tables 7.31 and 7.32 which are included at the end of this chapter (pages 436 and 437), present the latest data relating to social services in the autonomous communities of Andalucía and Navarra, which were received during the printing process and are not taken into account in the calculation of the other indicators included in this Report.

January 2006**

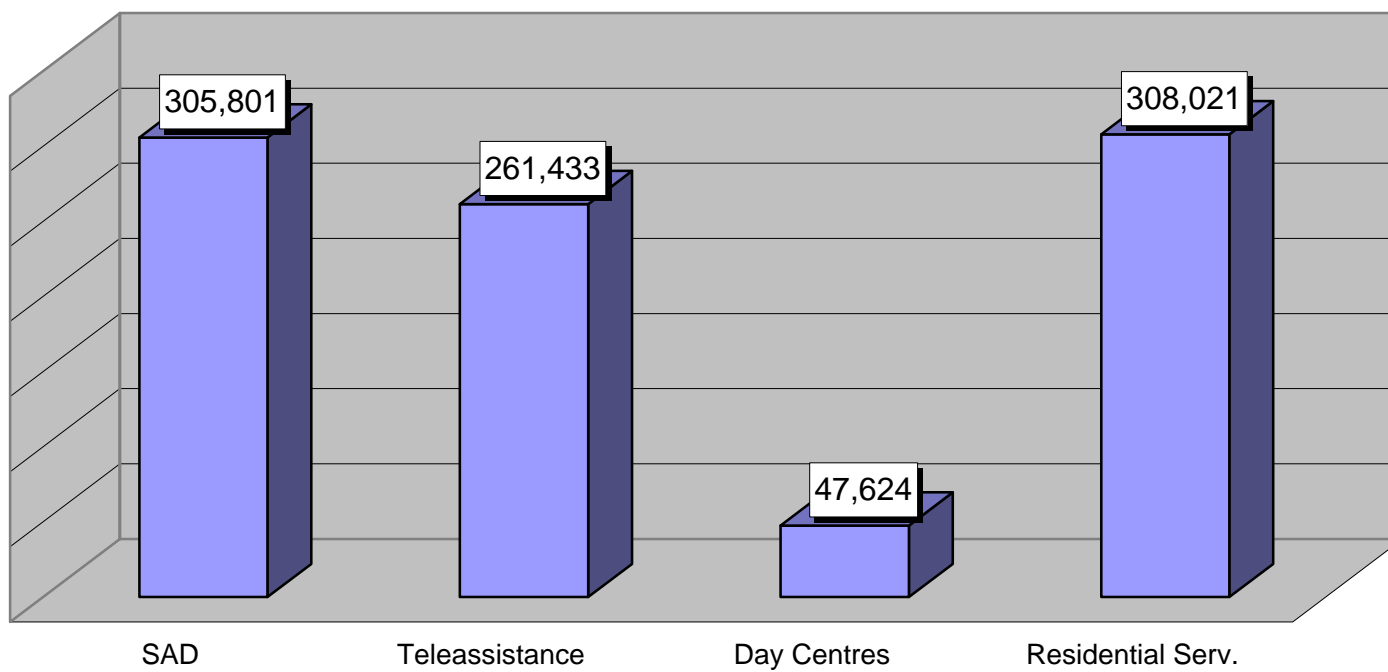
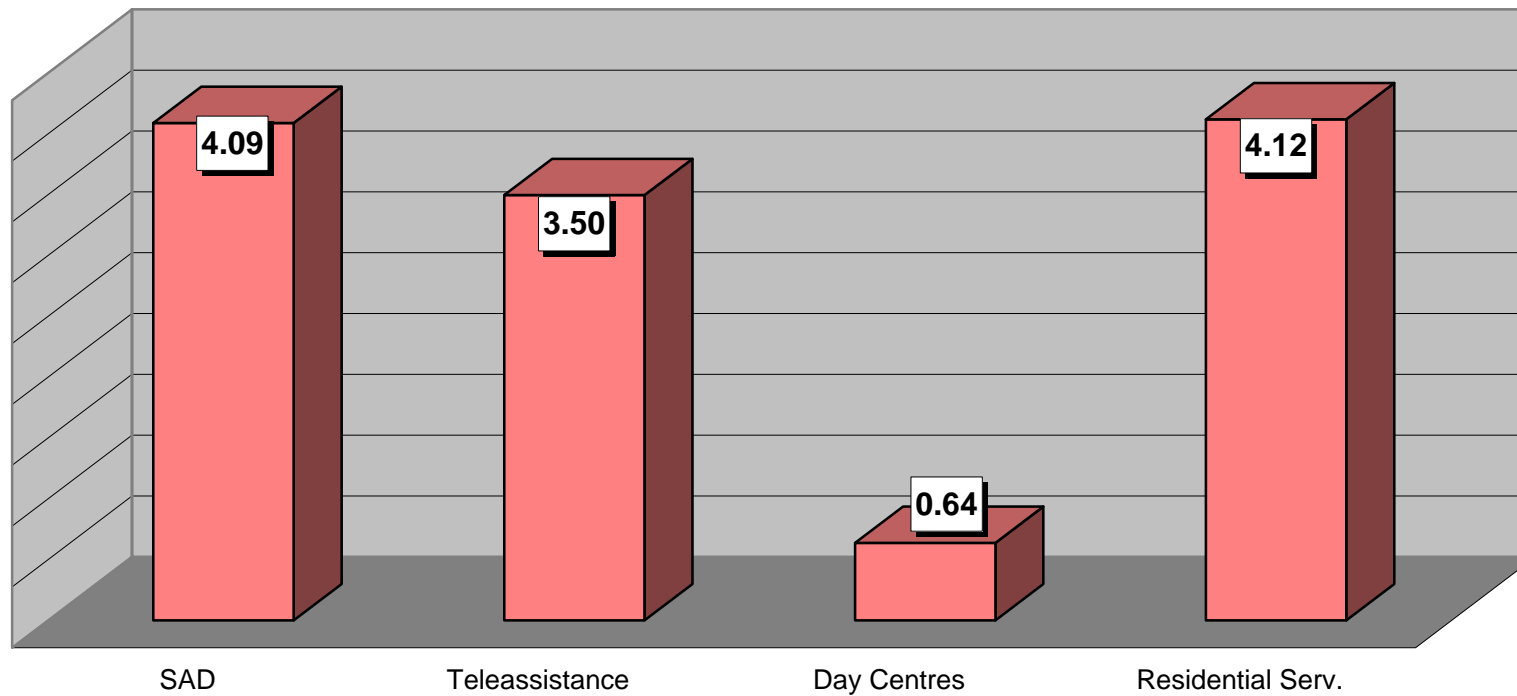


Figure 7. 2. Coverage rate for some social services for older people in Spain. January 2006

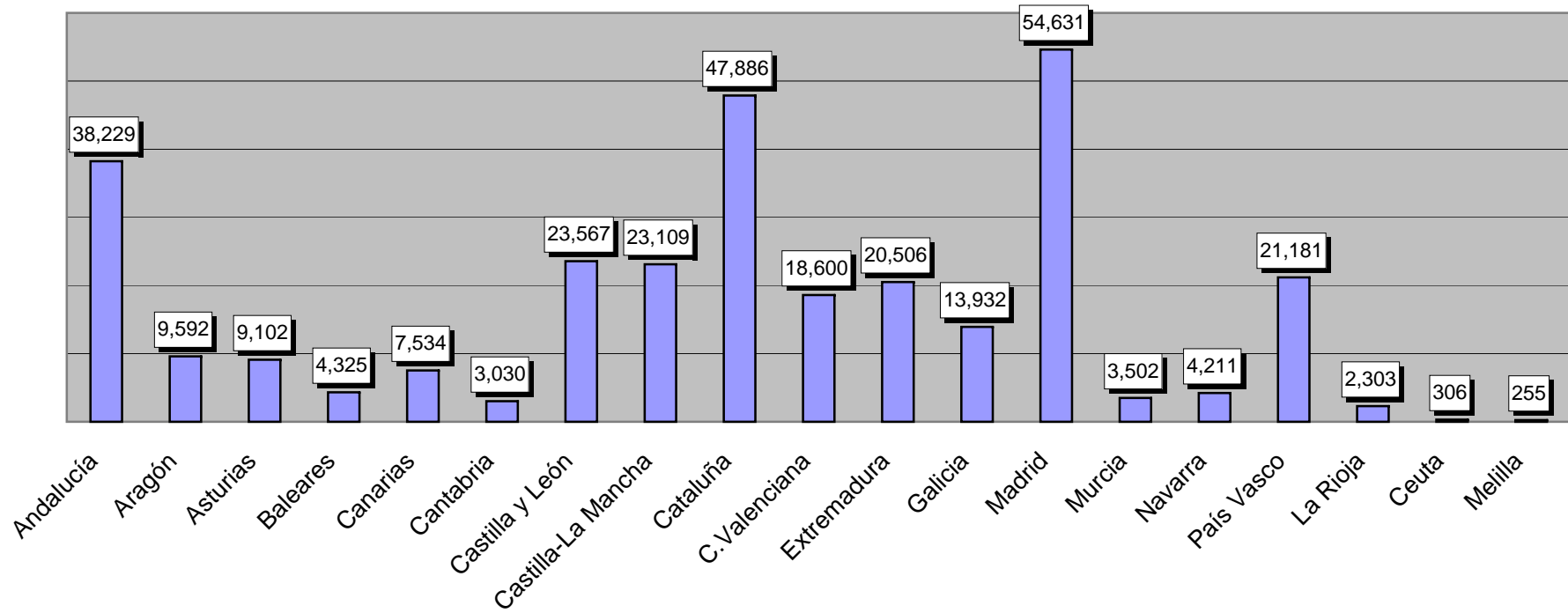

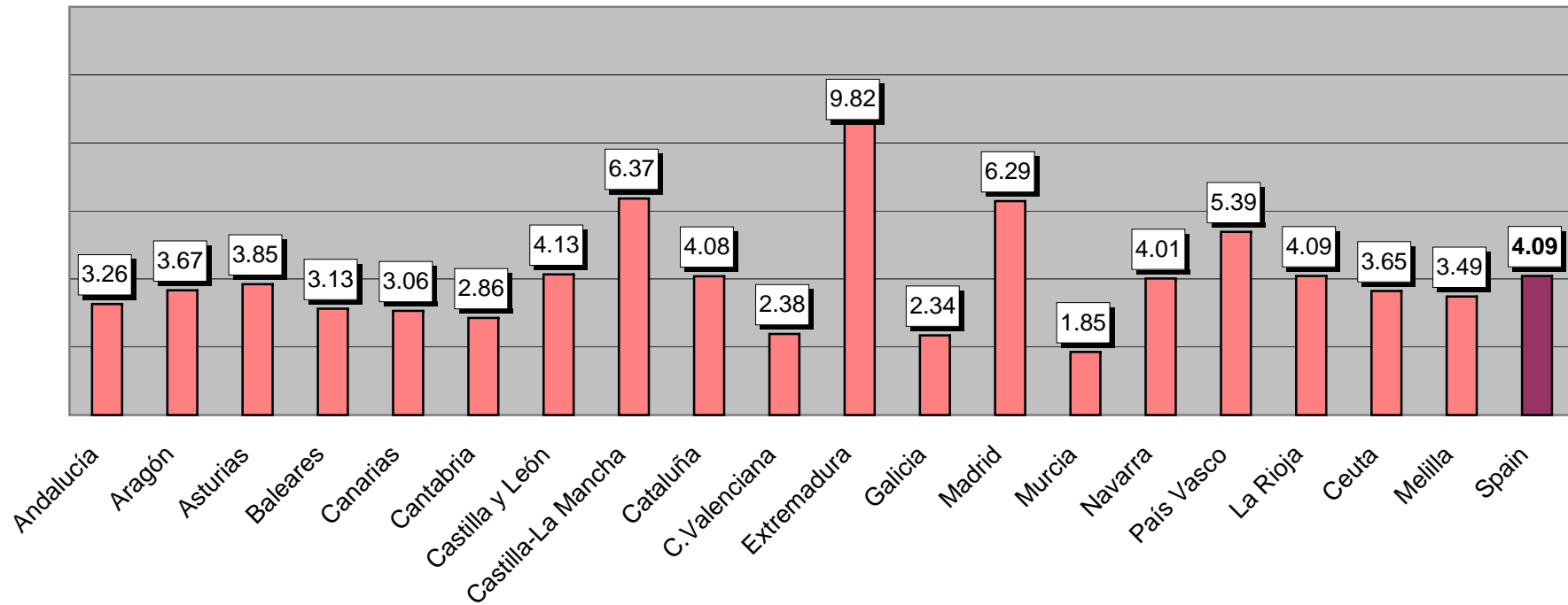

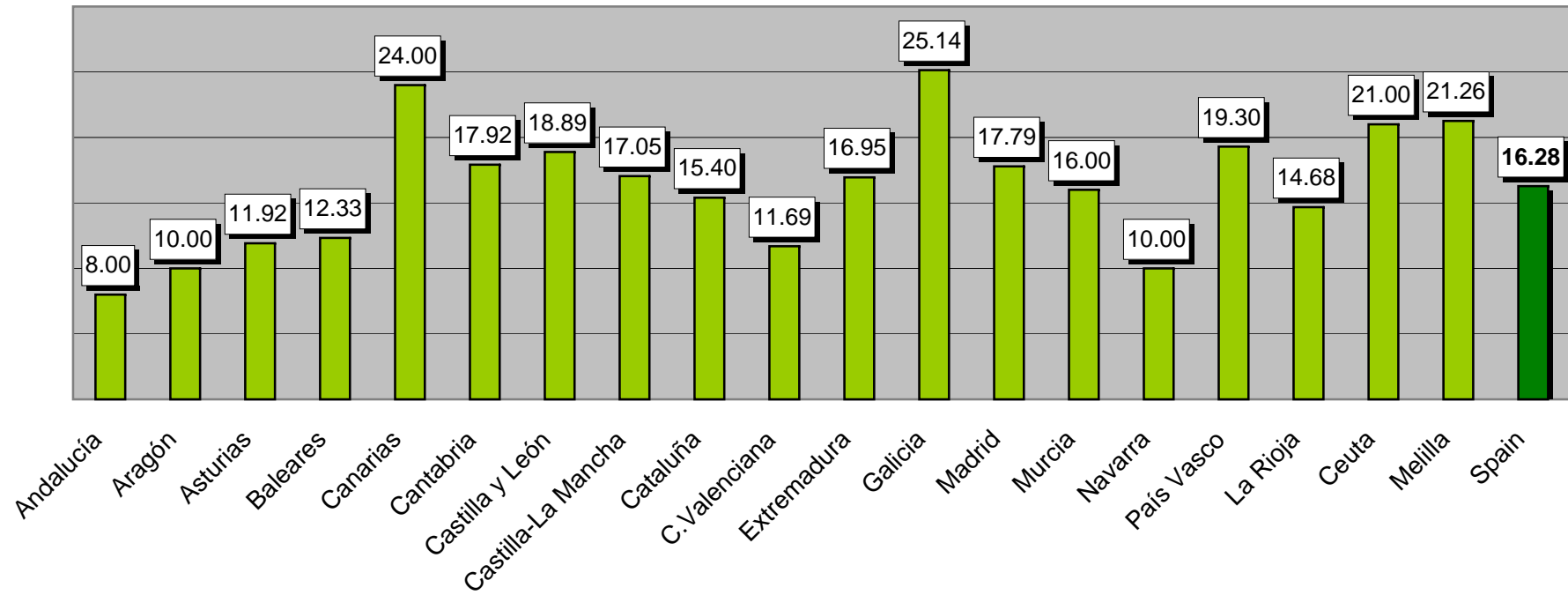

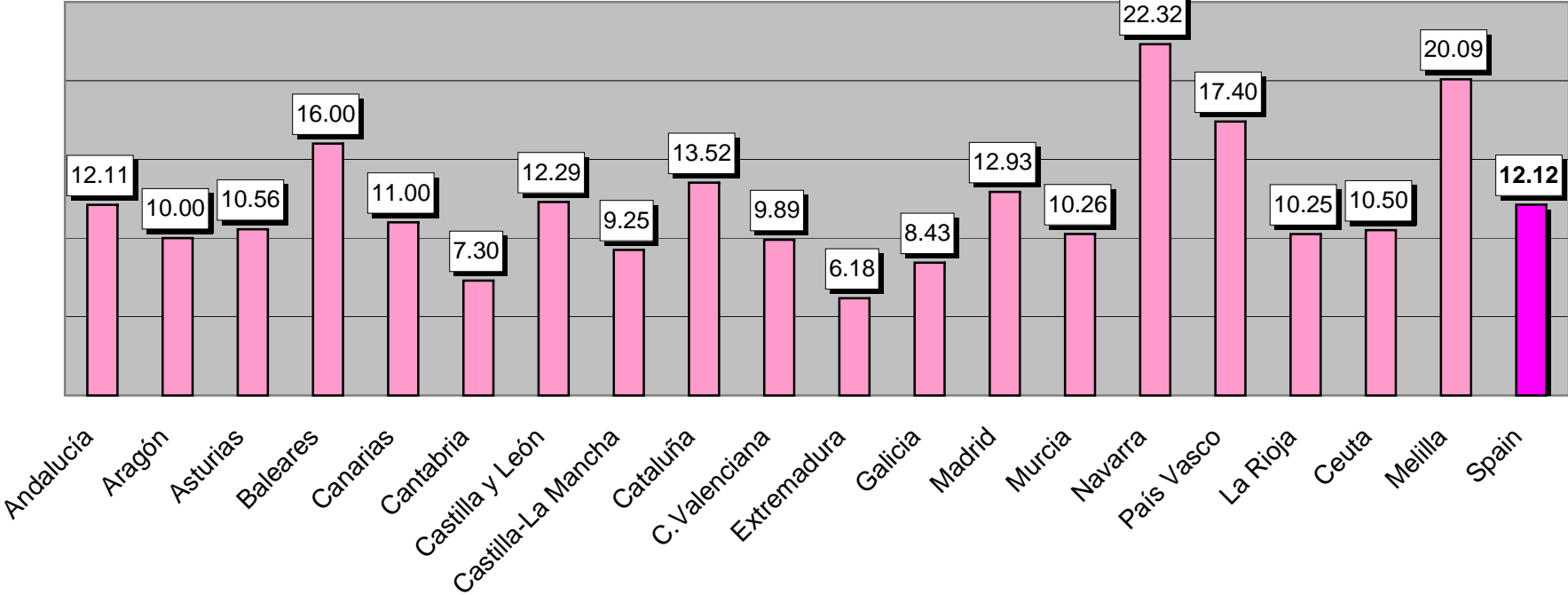

Indicators for social services for older people. Public home help service. Number of users, 1999 and 2006

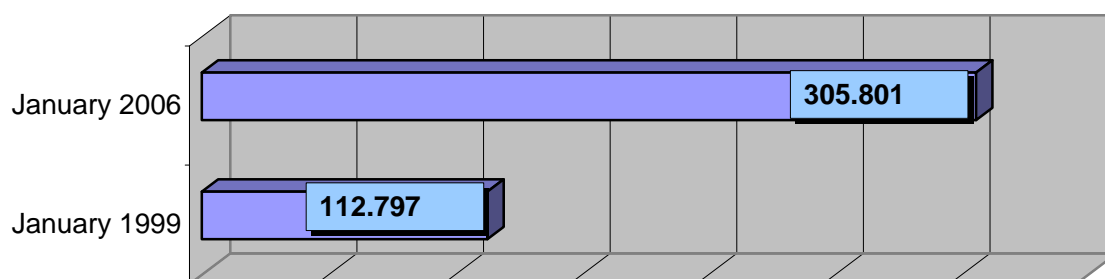

Indicators for social services for older people. Public home help service. Coverage rate, 1999 and 2006

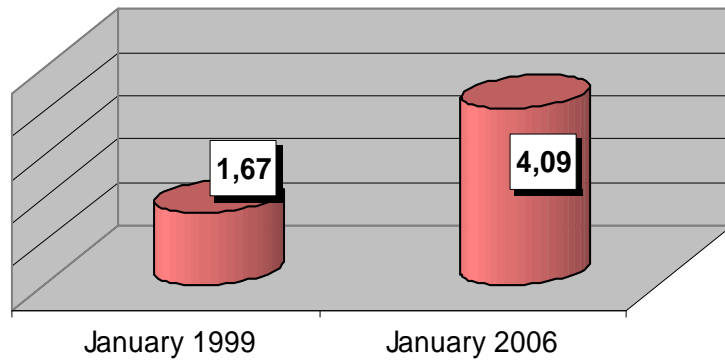

Indicators for social services for older people. Public home help service. Public price (euro/hour), 1999 and 2006

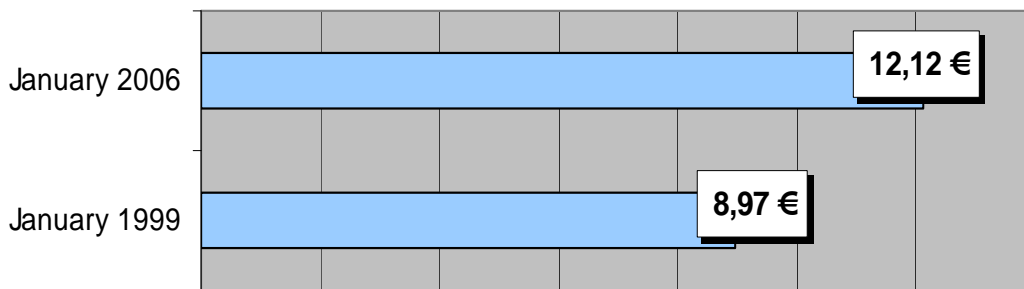

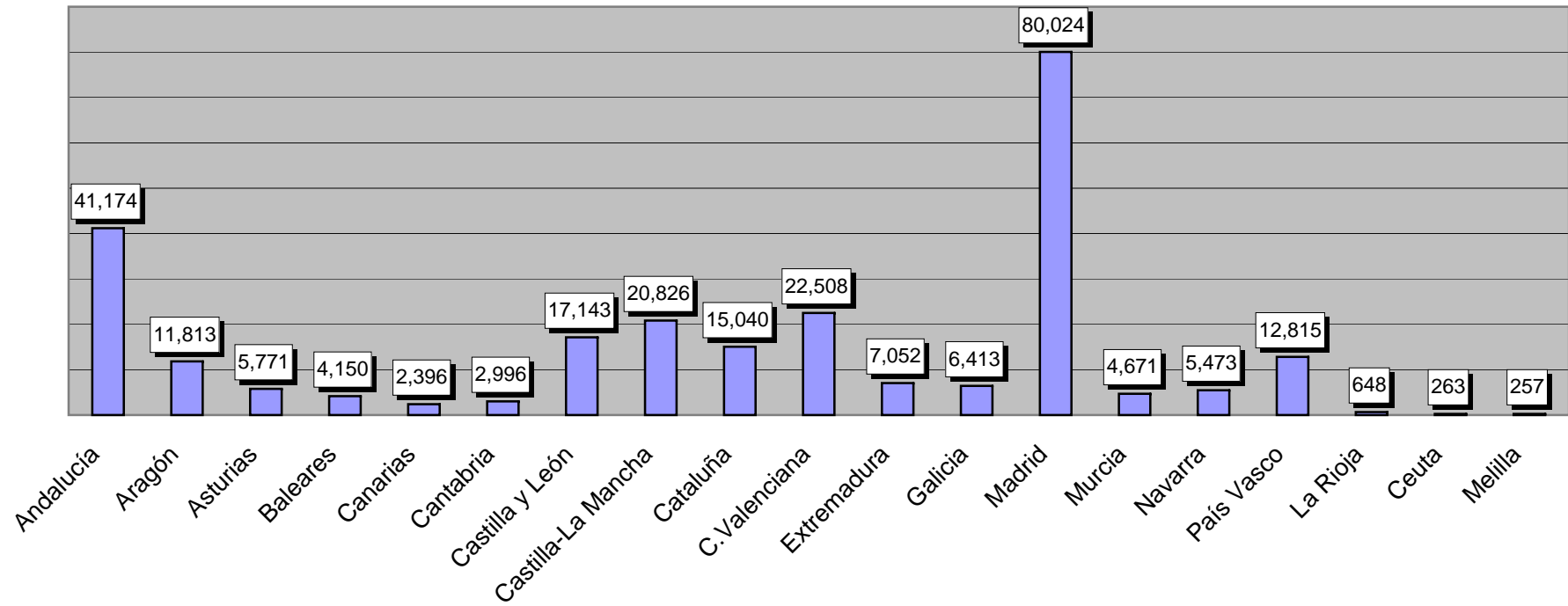

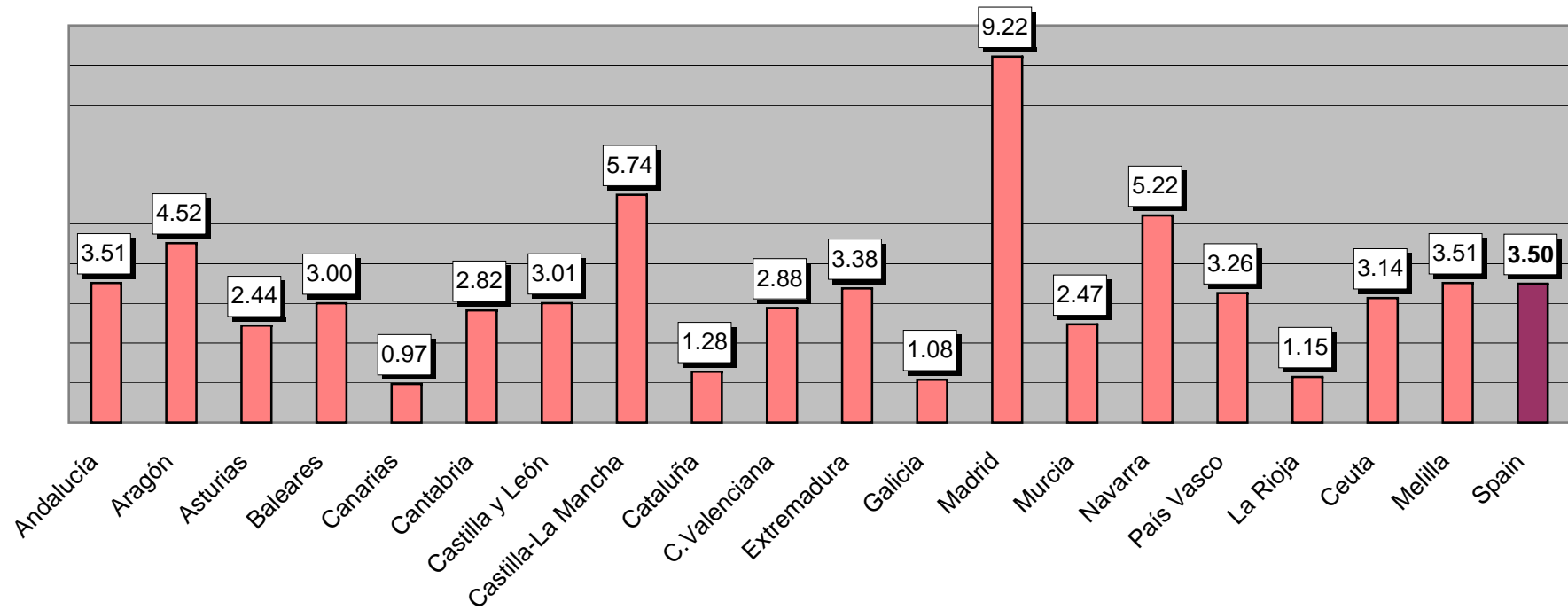

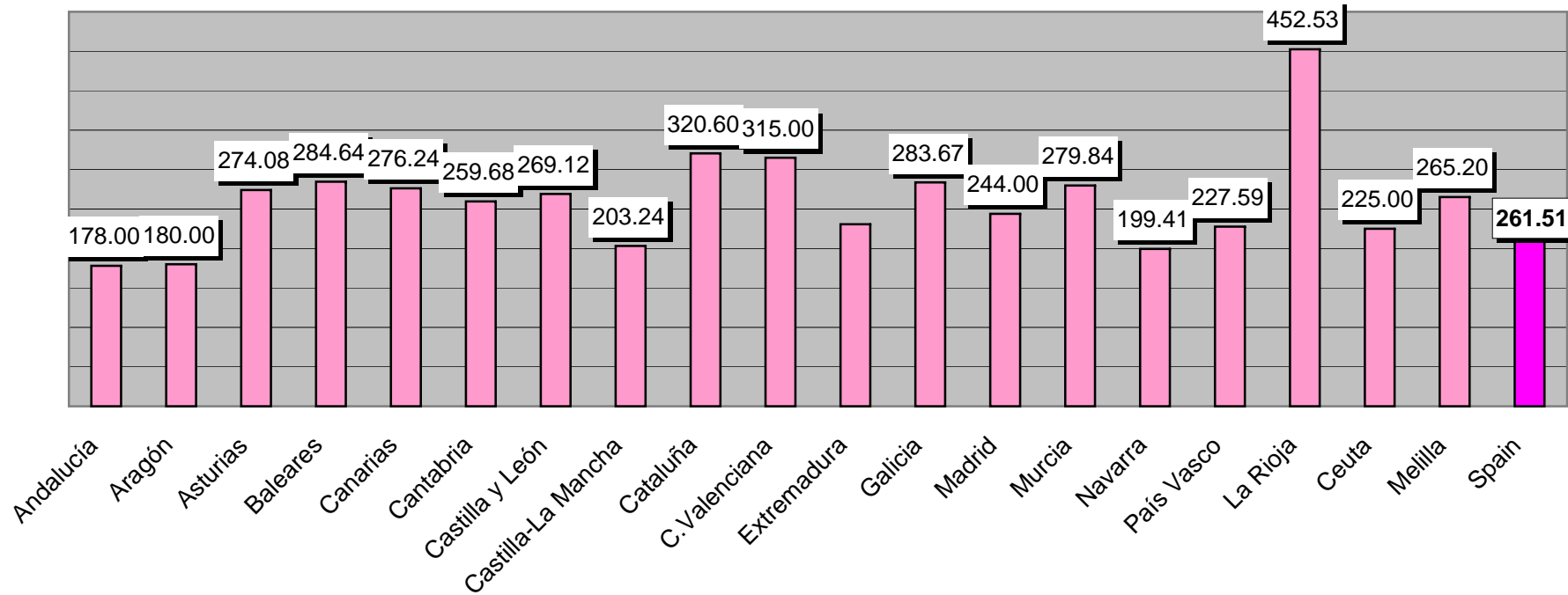

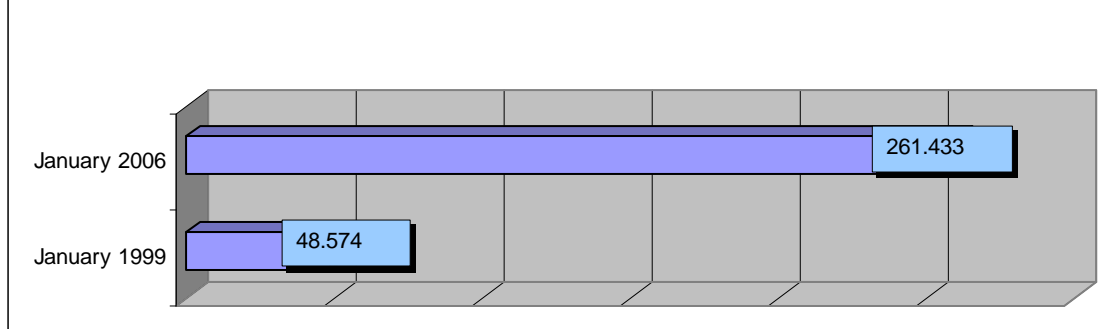

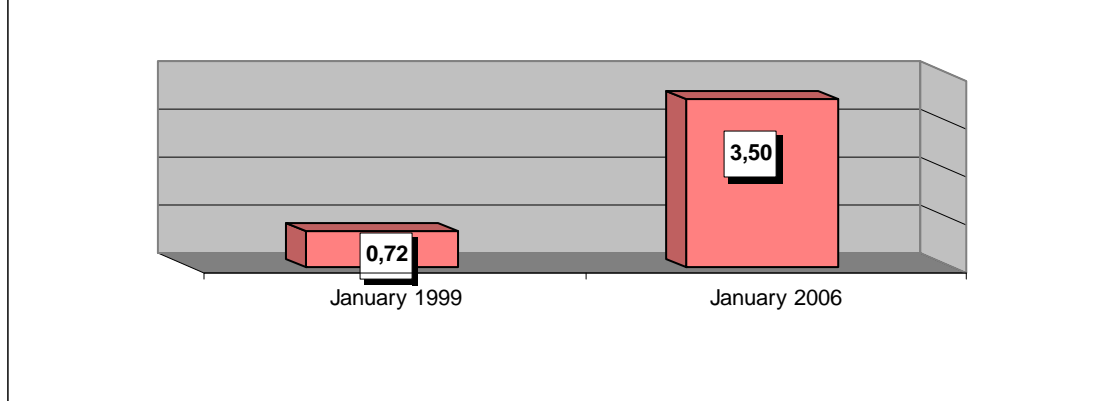

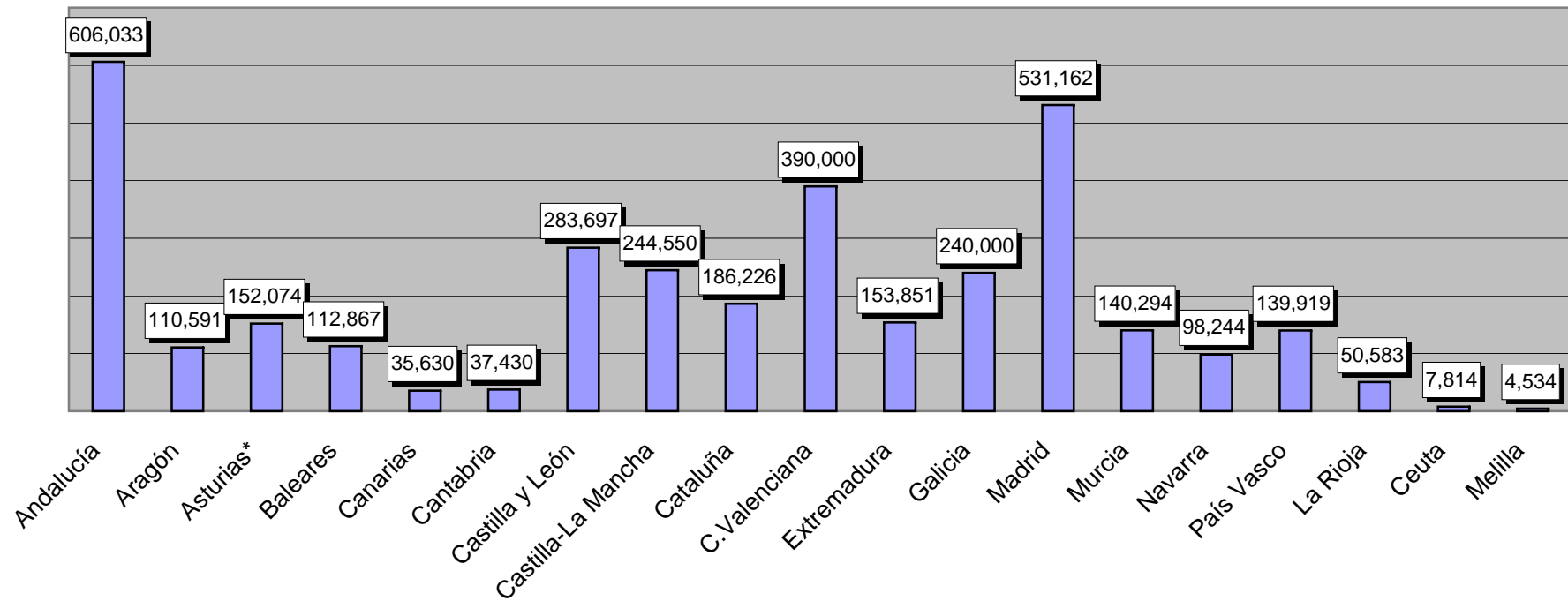

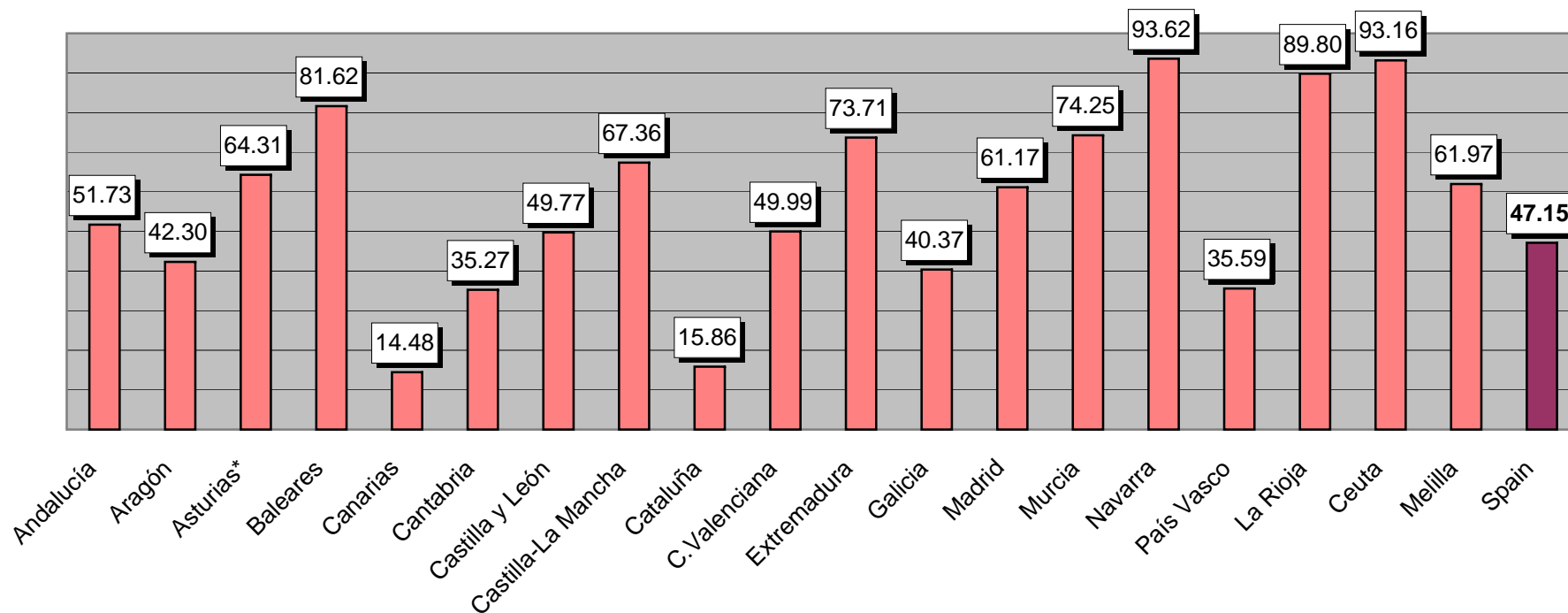
Figure 7.15. Clubs for older people. Number of members. January 2006

Indicators for social services for older people. Clubs. Number of members, 1999 and 2006

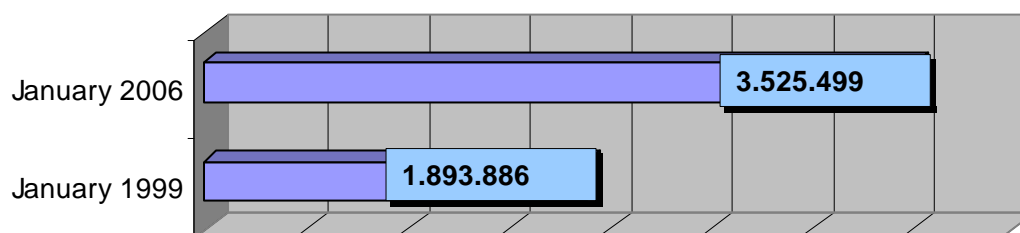

Indicators for social services for older people. Clubs. Coverage rate, 1999 and 2006

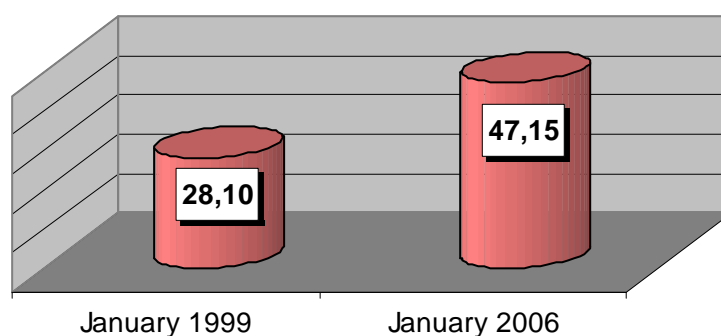

Number of centres, 1999 and 2006

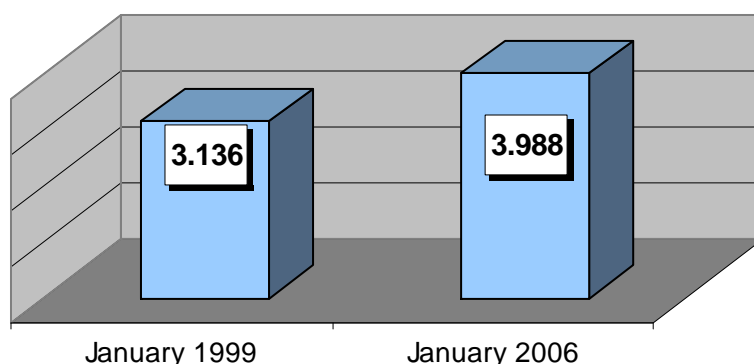

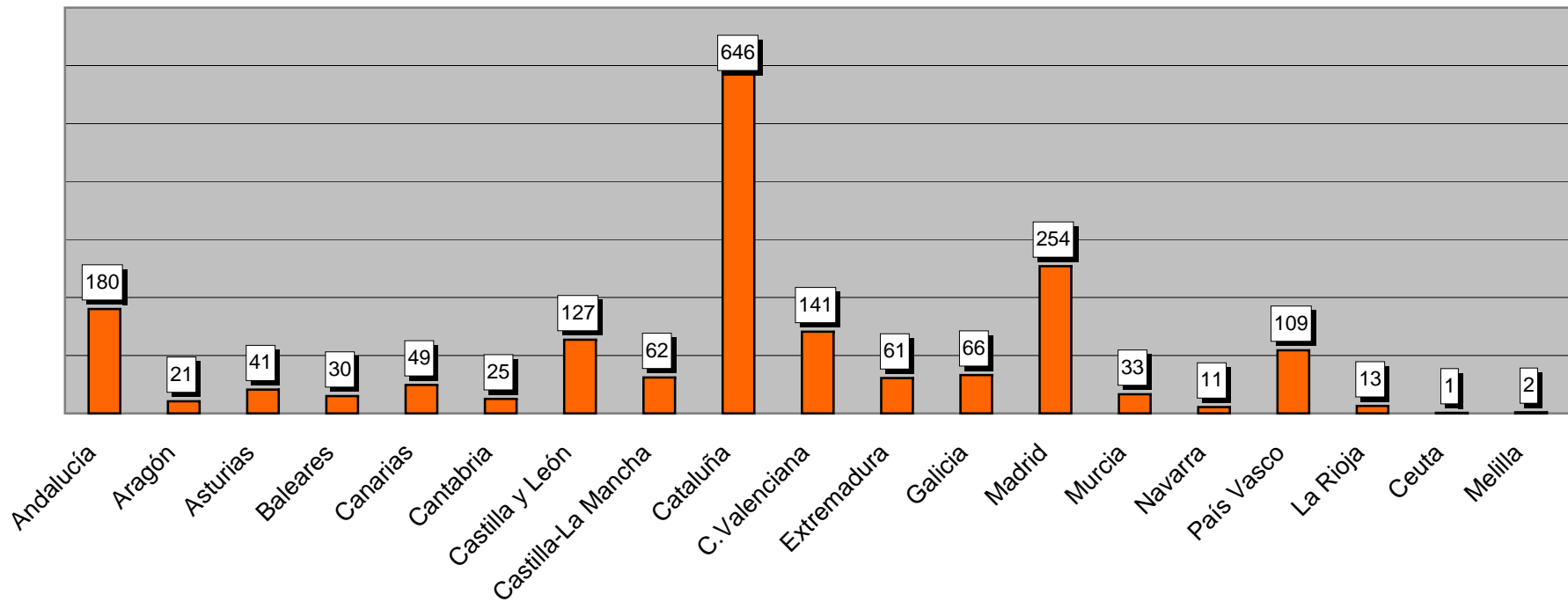

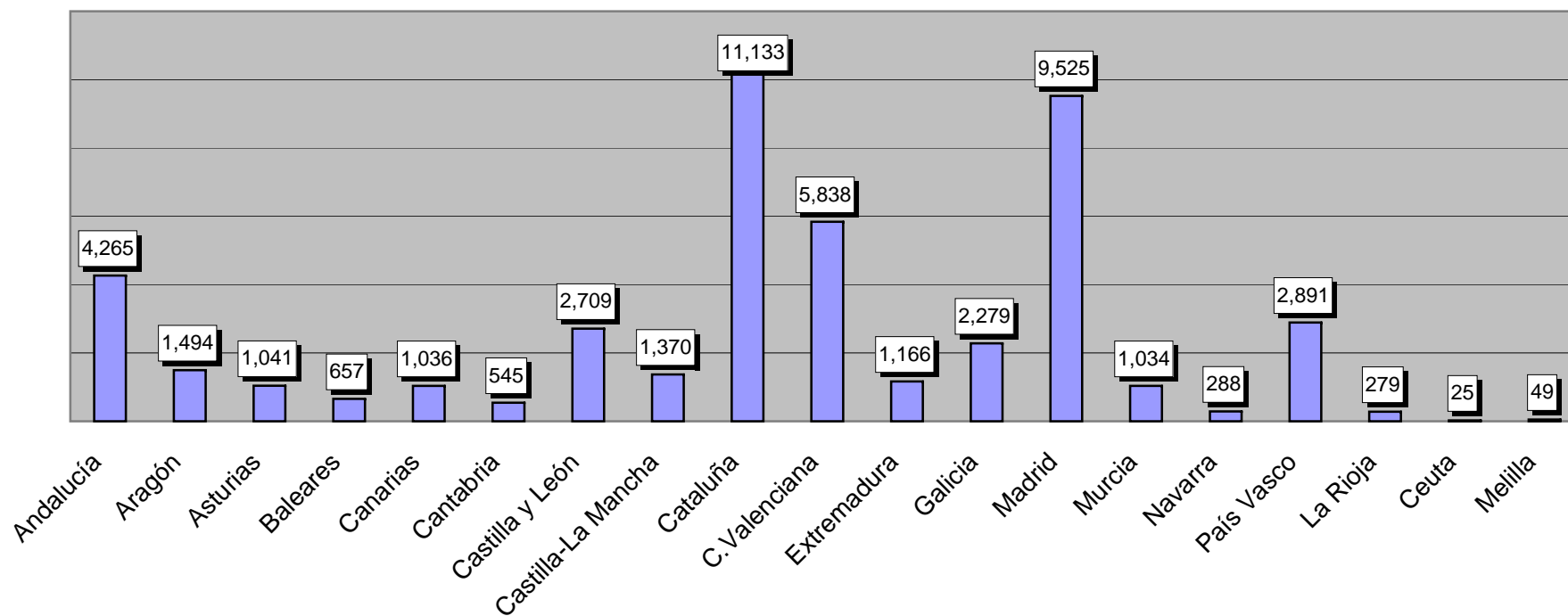

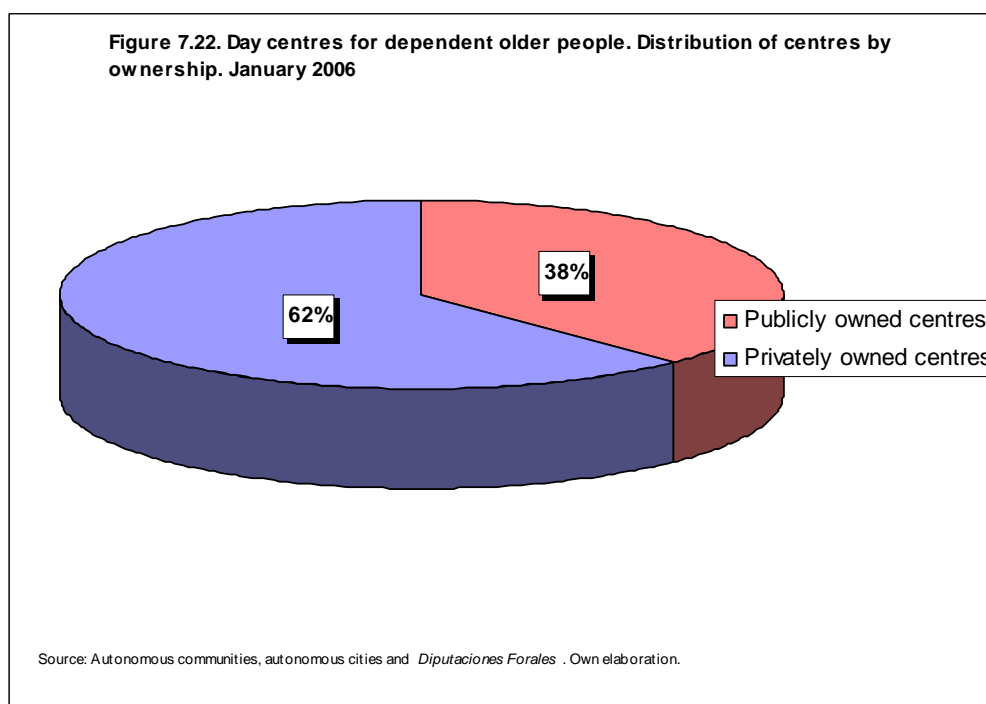

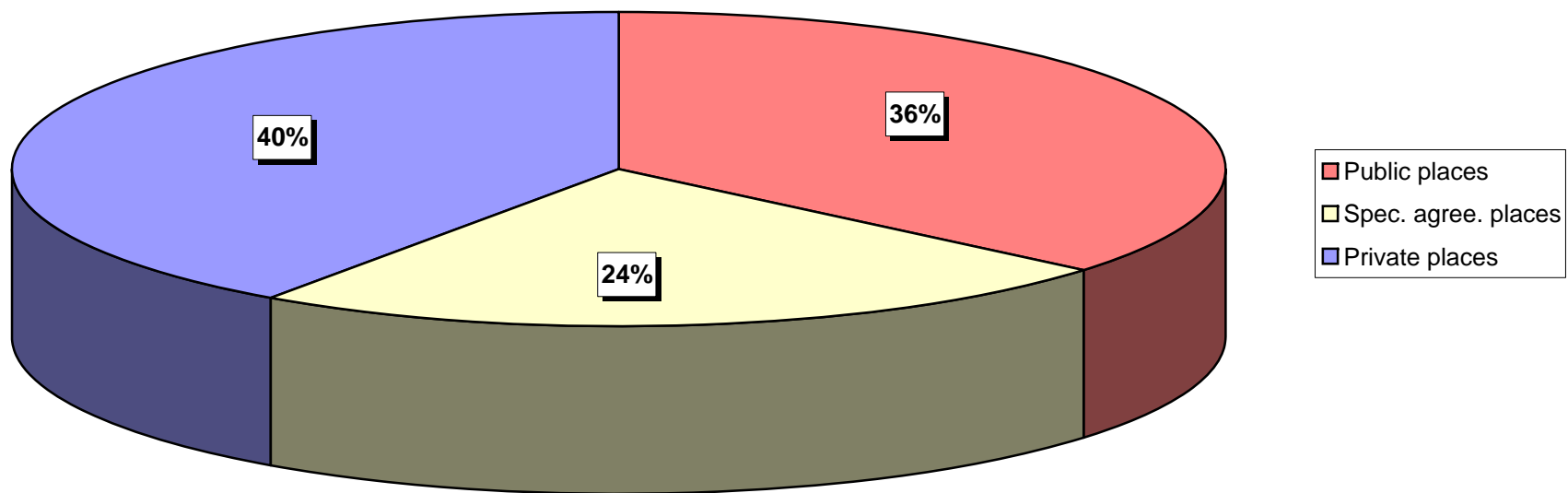

Indicators for social services for older people. Day centres for dependent people. Number publicly funded places, 1999 and 2006

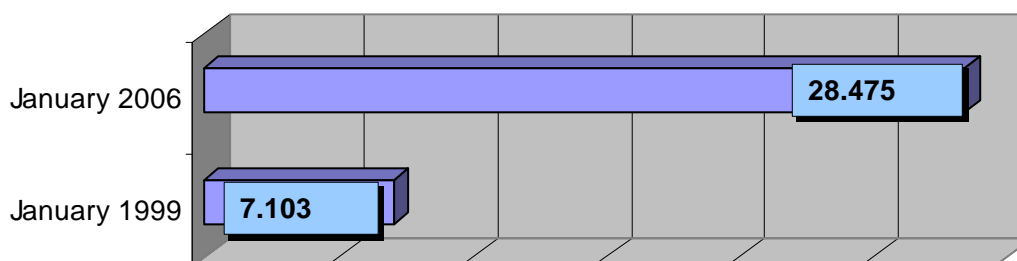

Indicators for social services for older people. Day centres for dependent people. Coverage rate for publicly funded places, 1999 and 2006

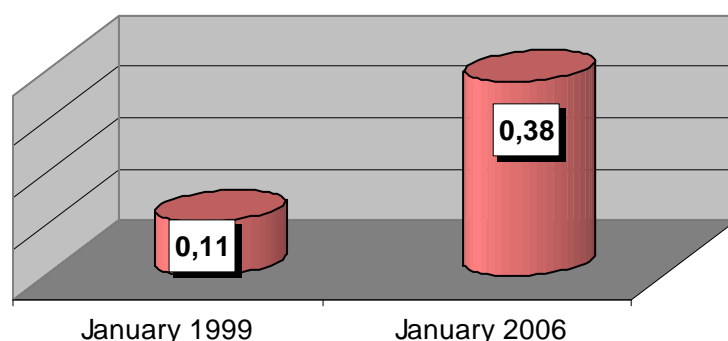

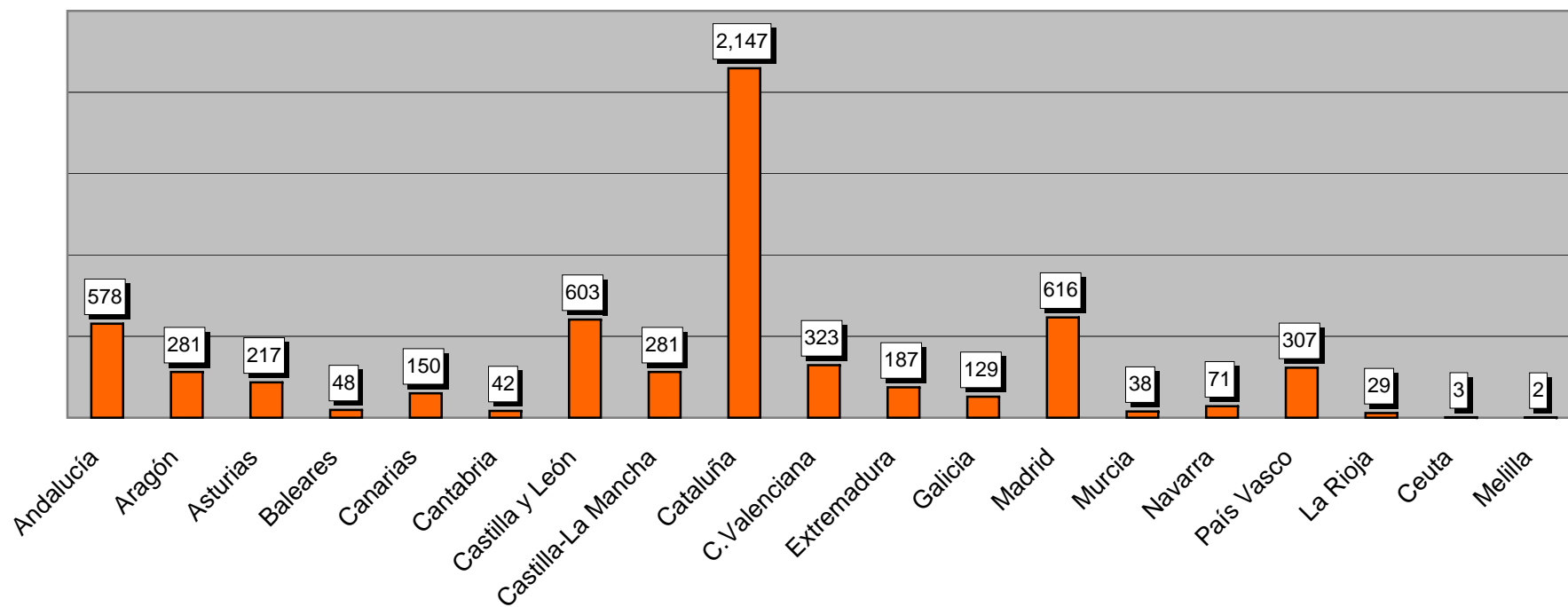

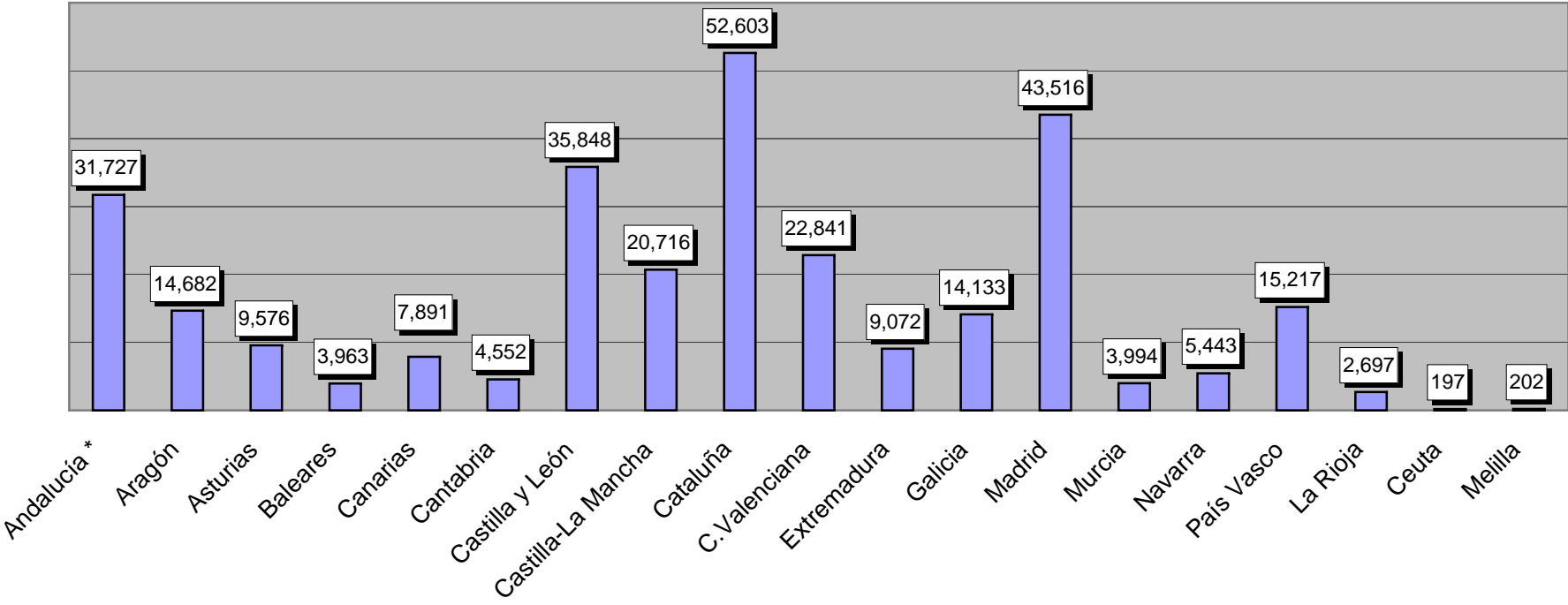

Figure 7.26. Residential centres. Number of centres. January 2006



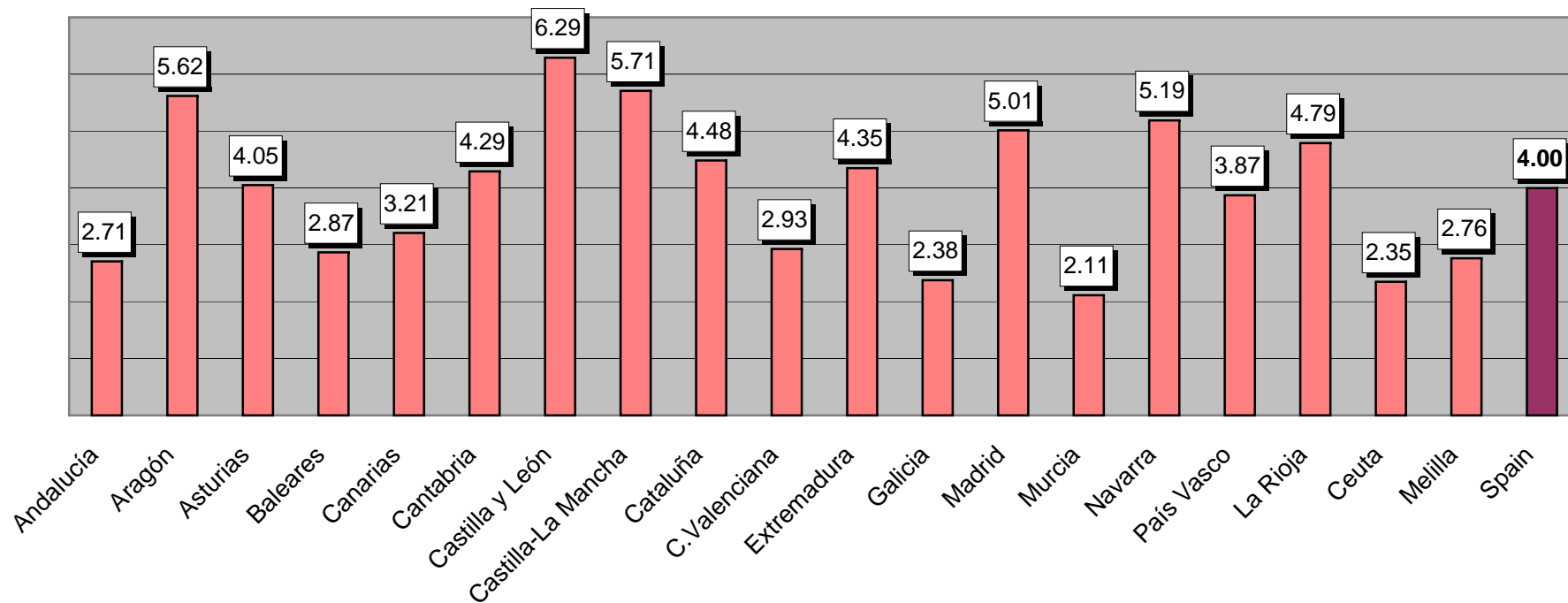

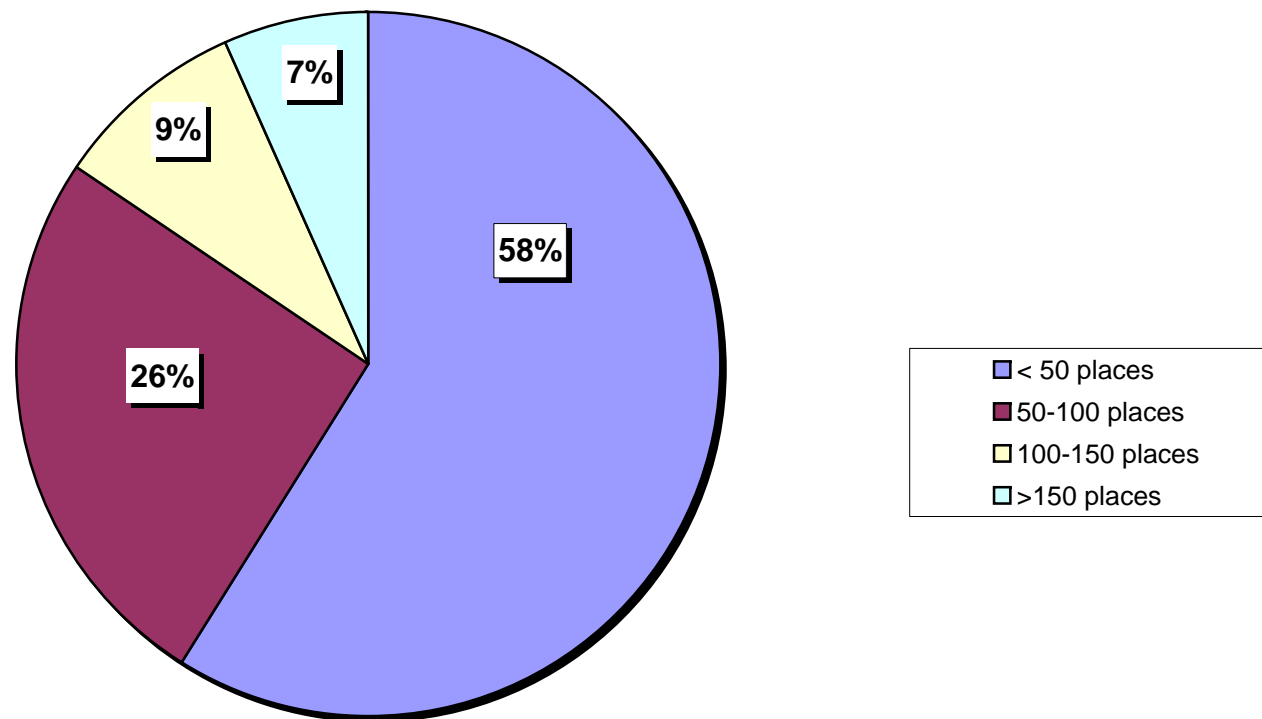

Distribution of places. January 1999

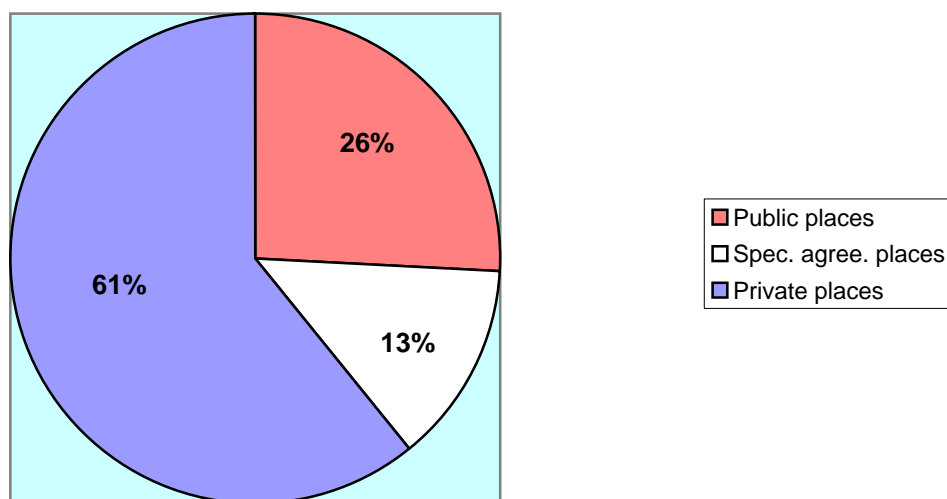
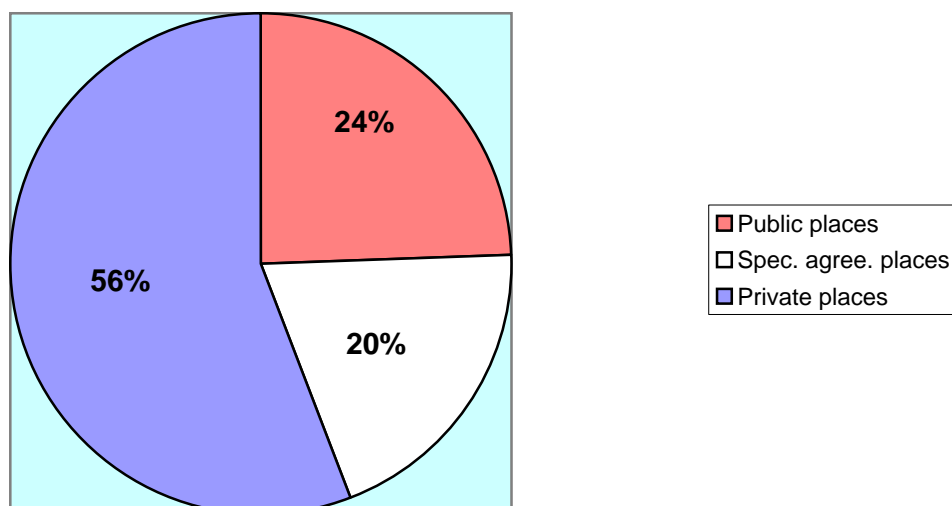

Distribution of centres by ownership. January 1999

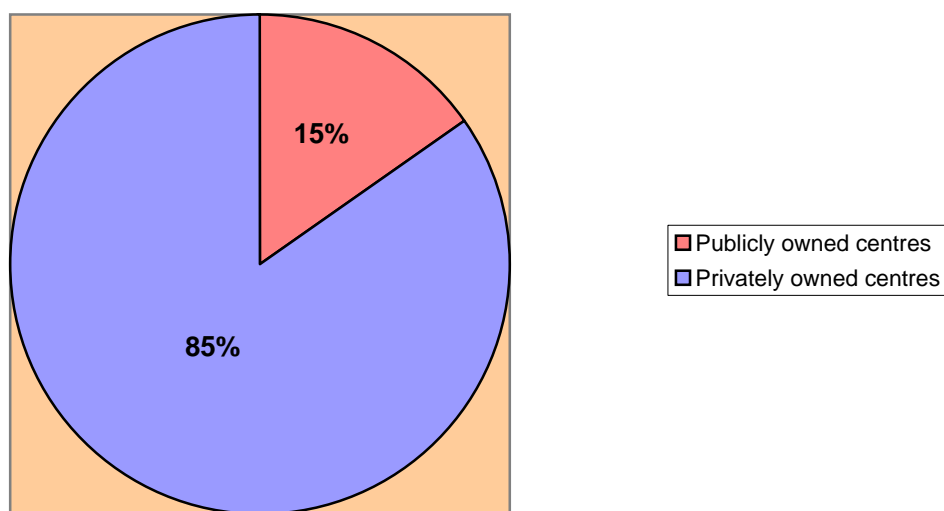
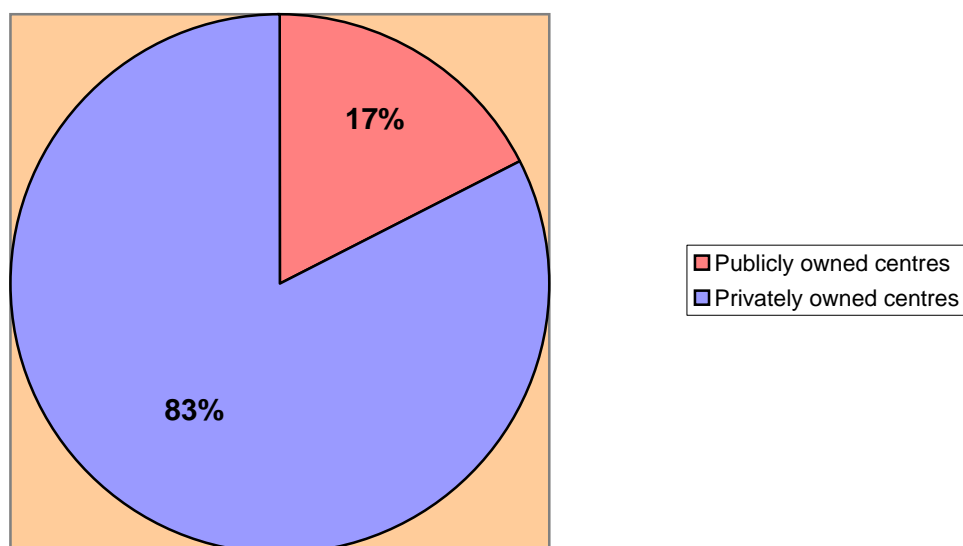


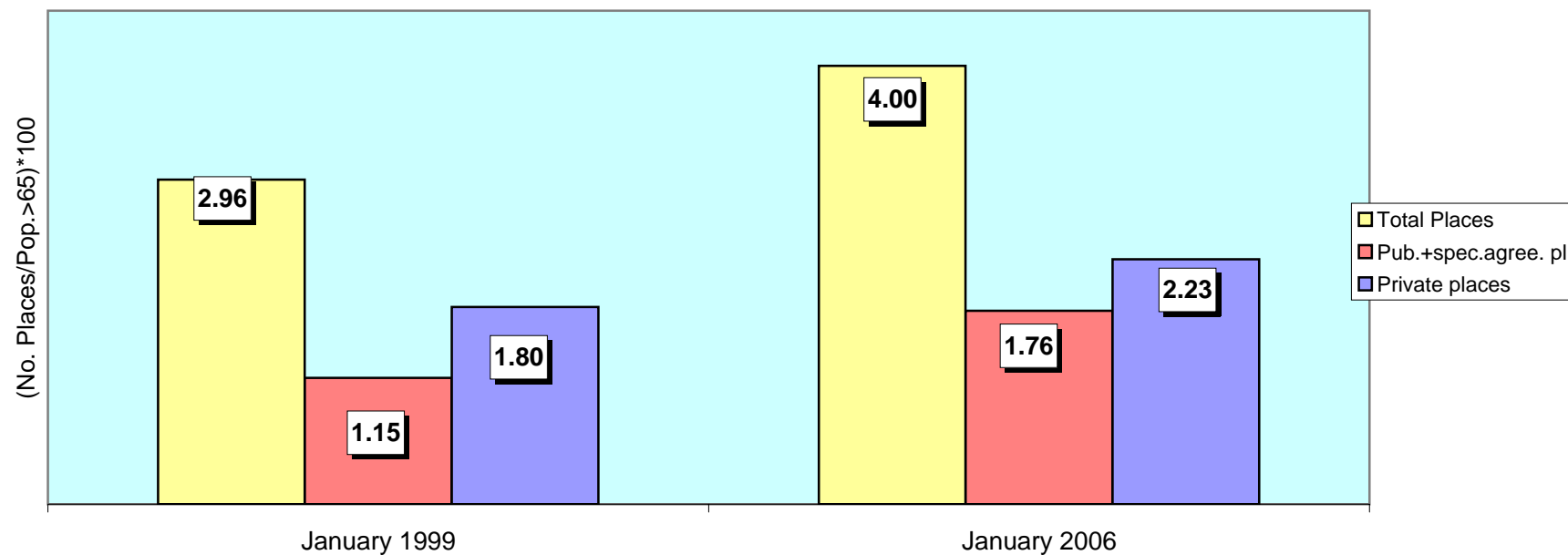

2006

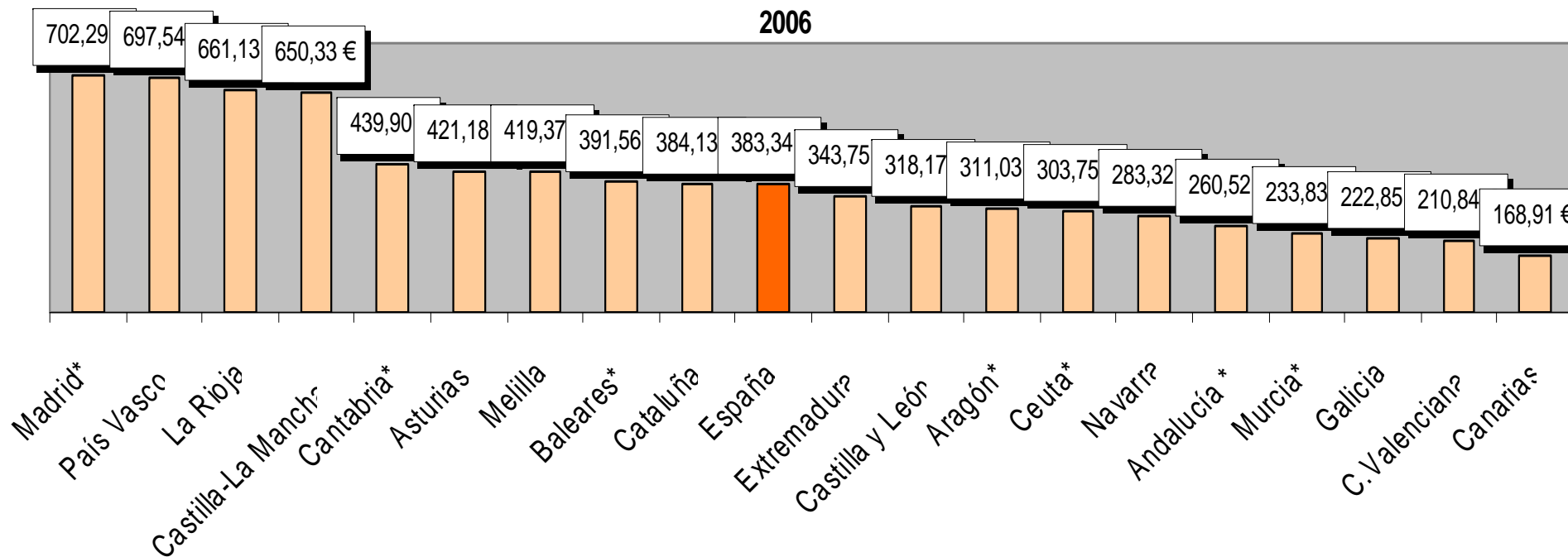
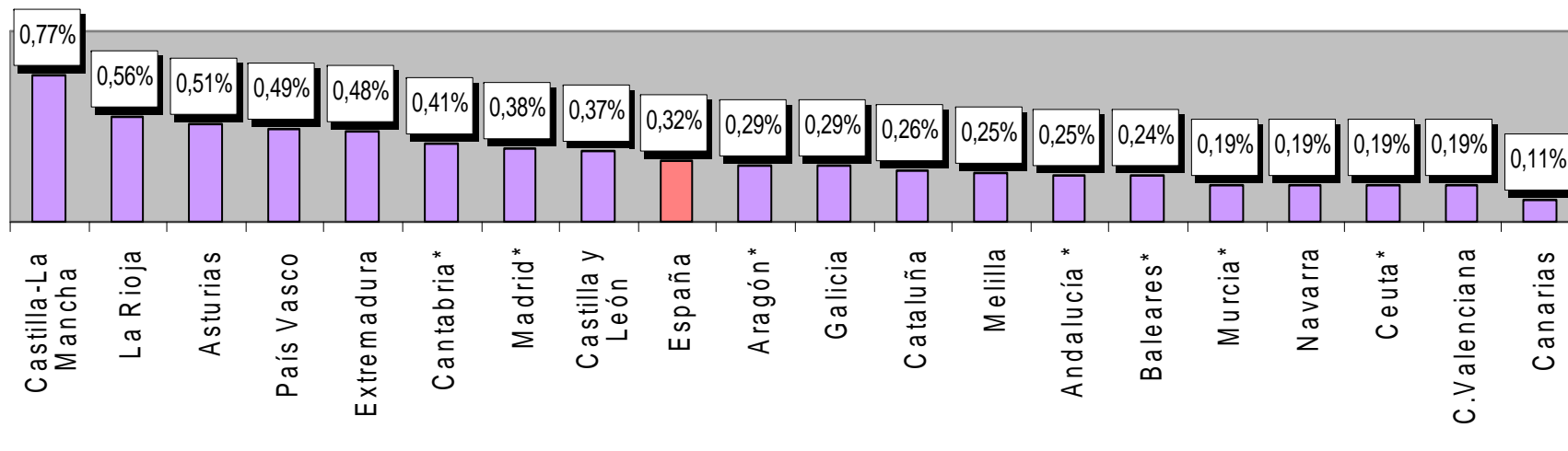


Figure 7.36. Social service budget for older people with respect to GDP. (Expenditure percentage/GDP).
January 2006



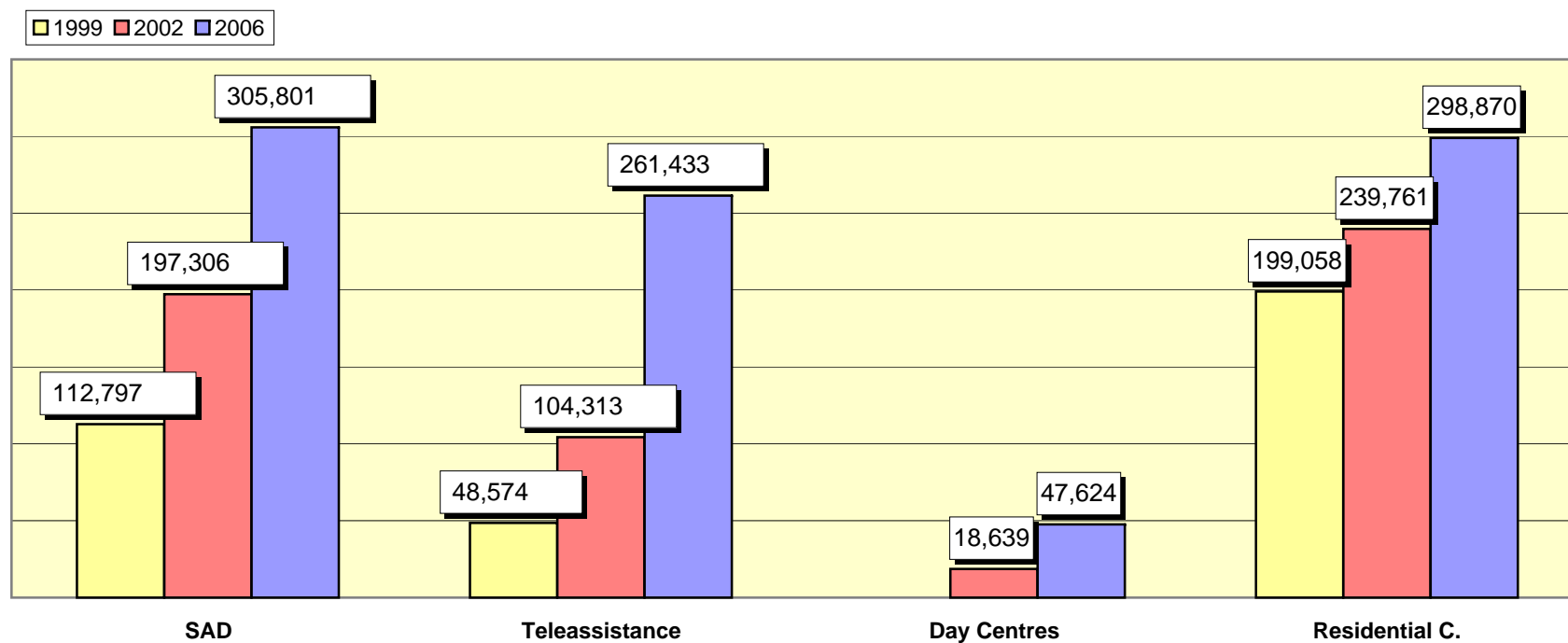

Figure 7.1. Evolution of some social services for older people in Spain, 1999-2006



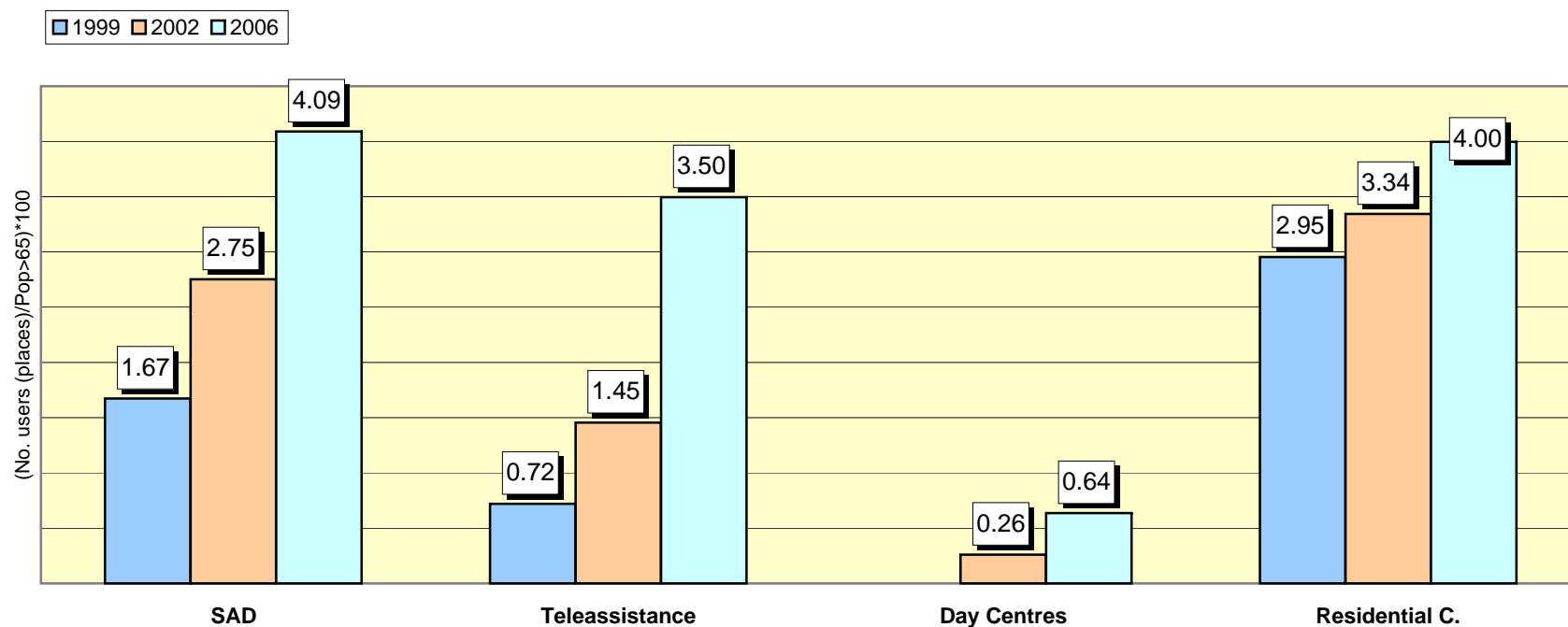

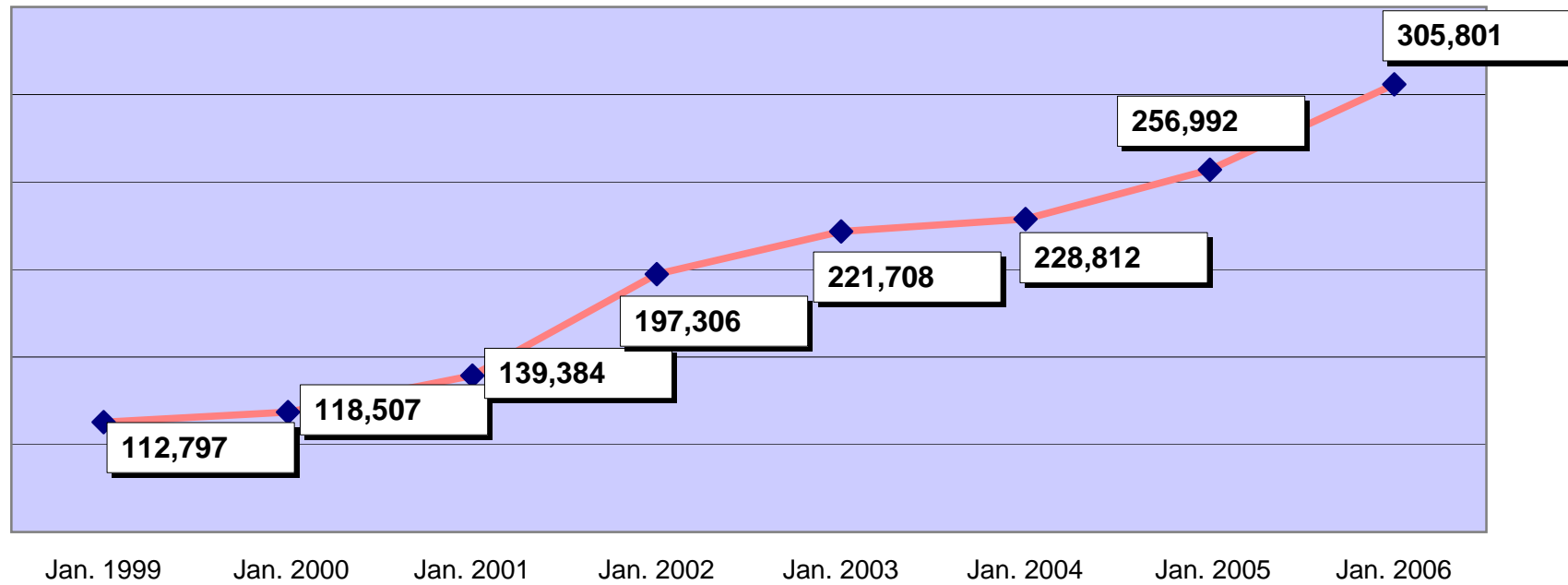

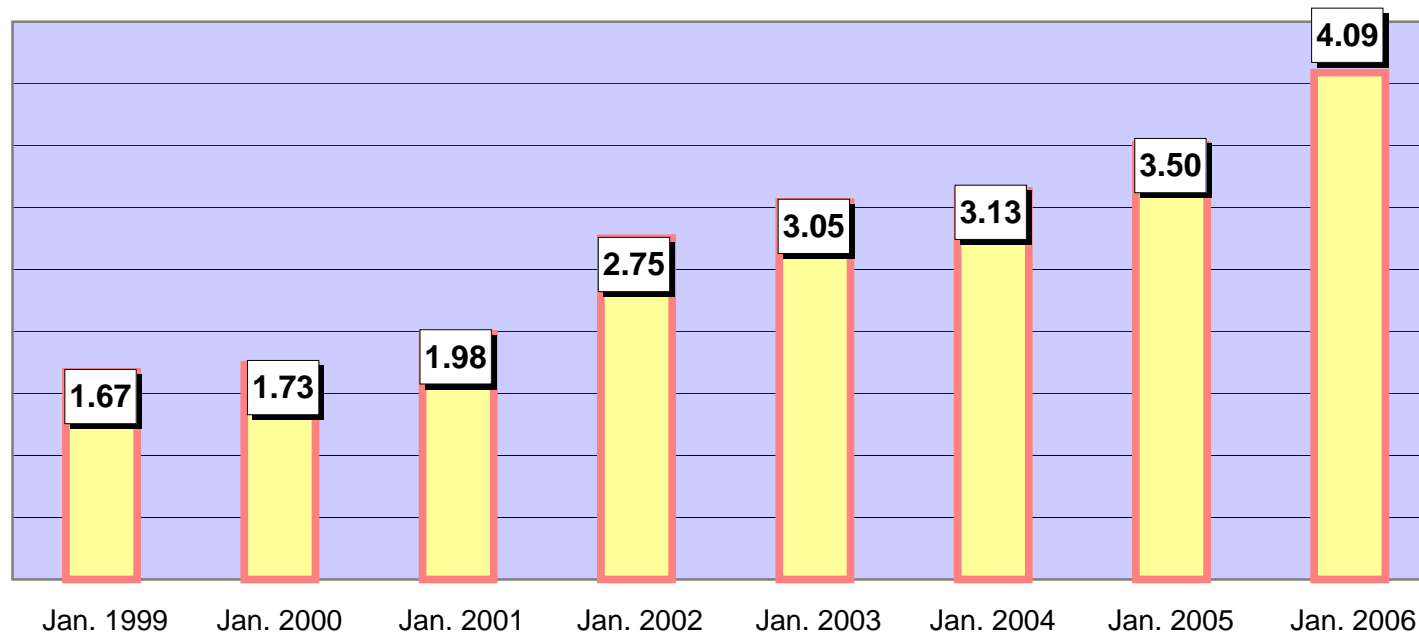

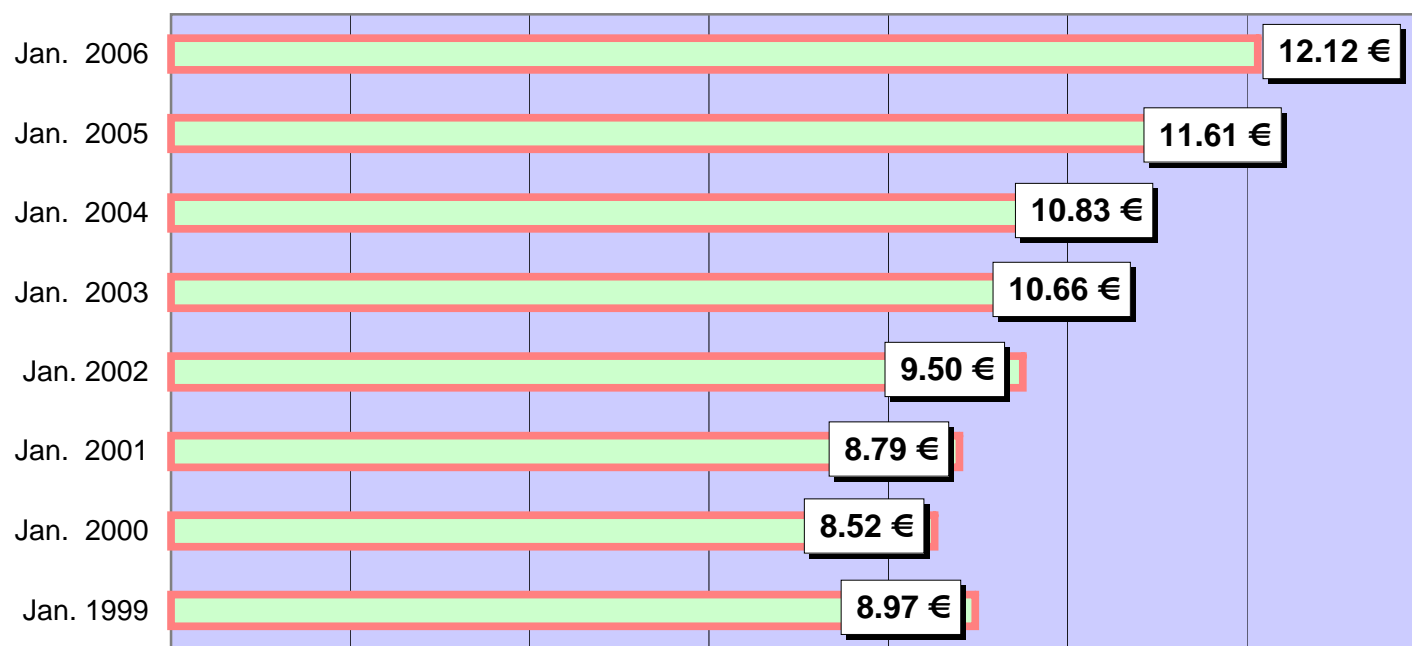

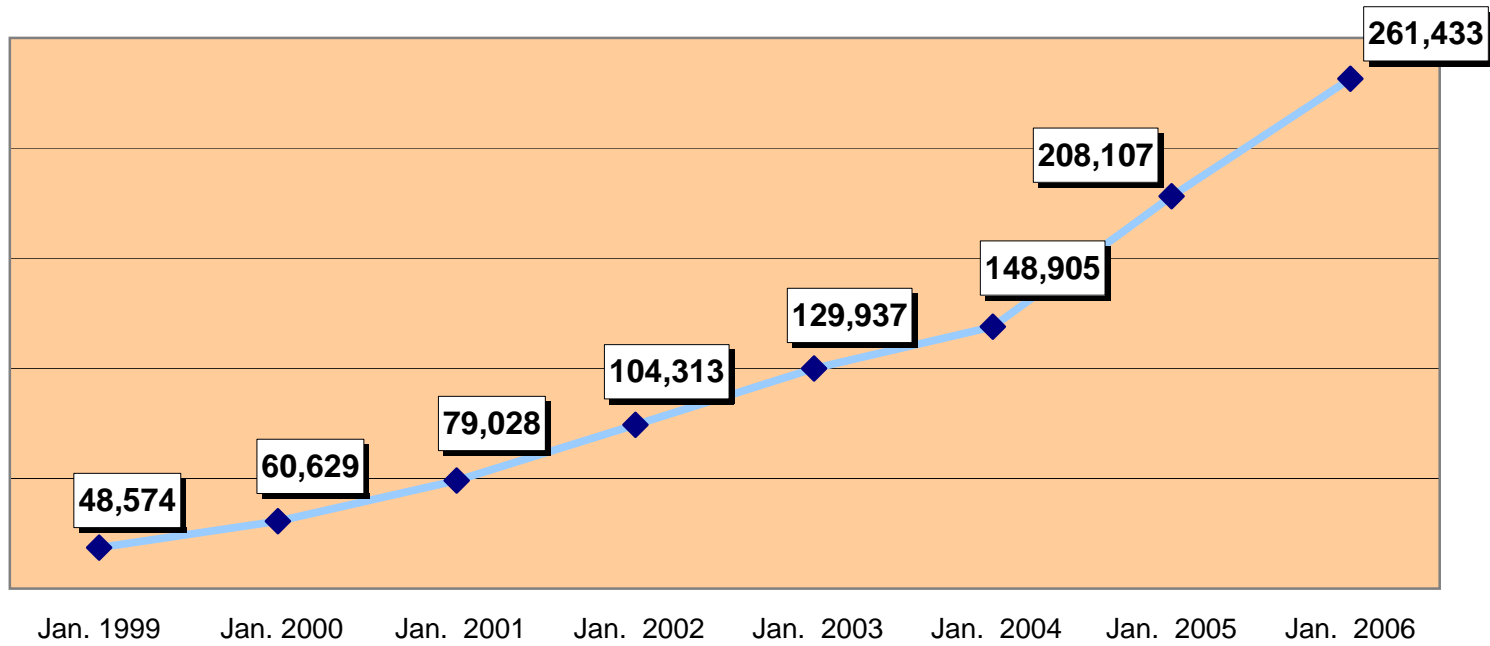

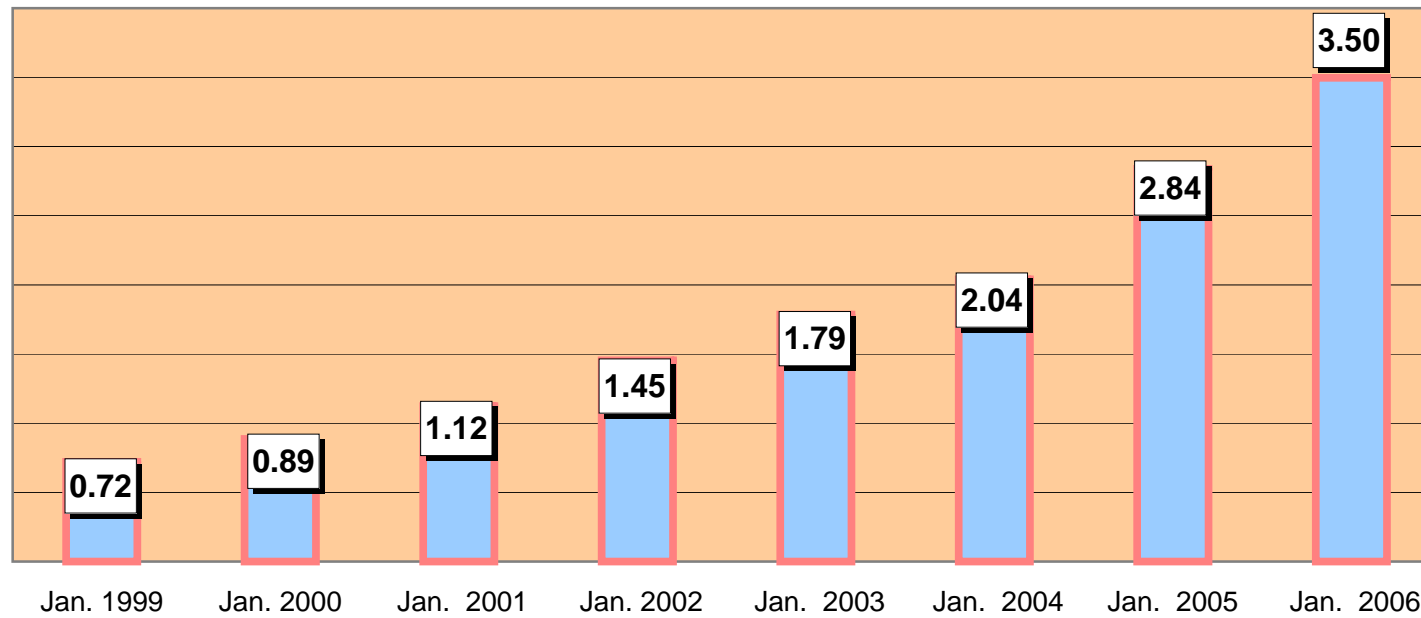

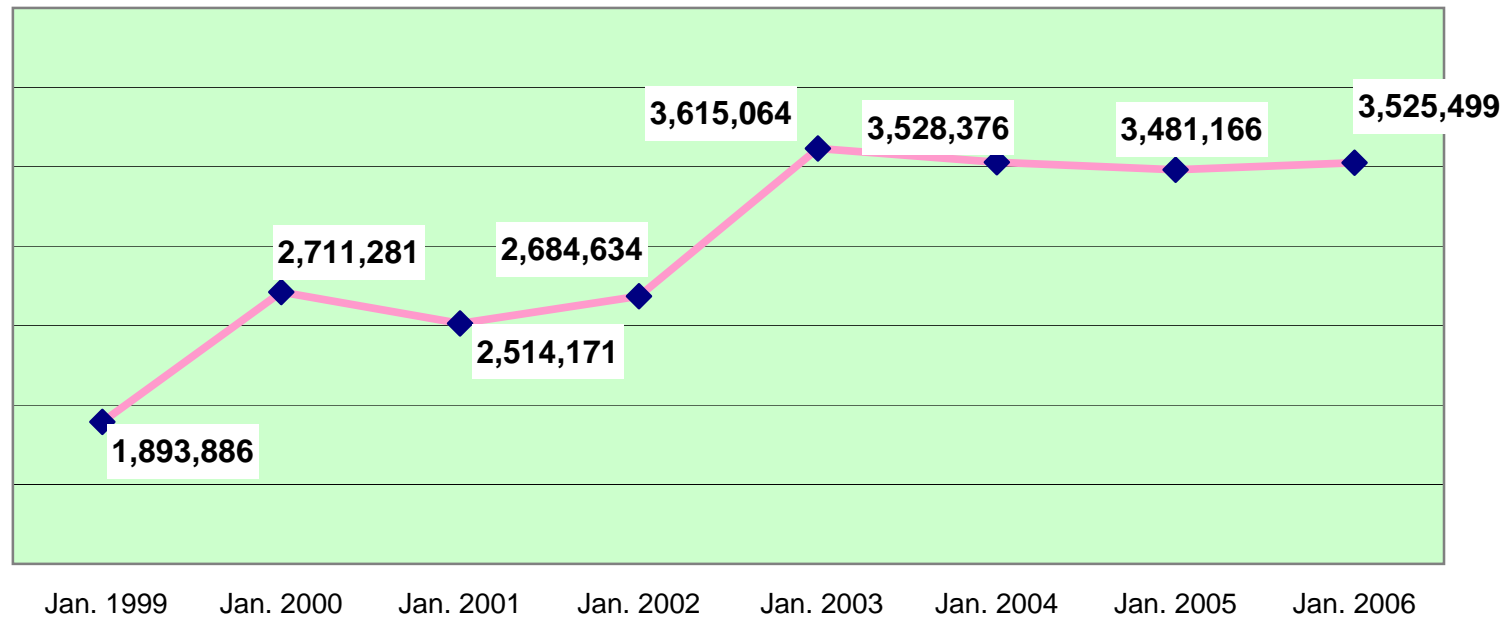

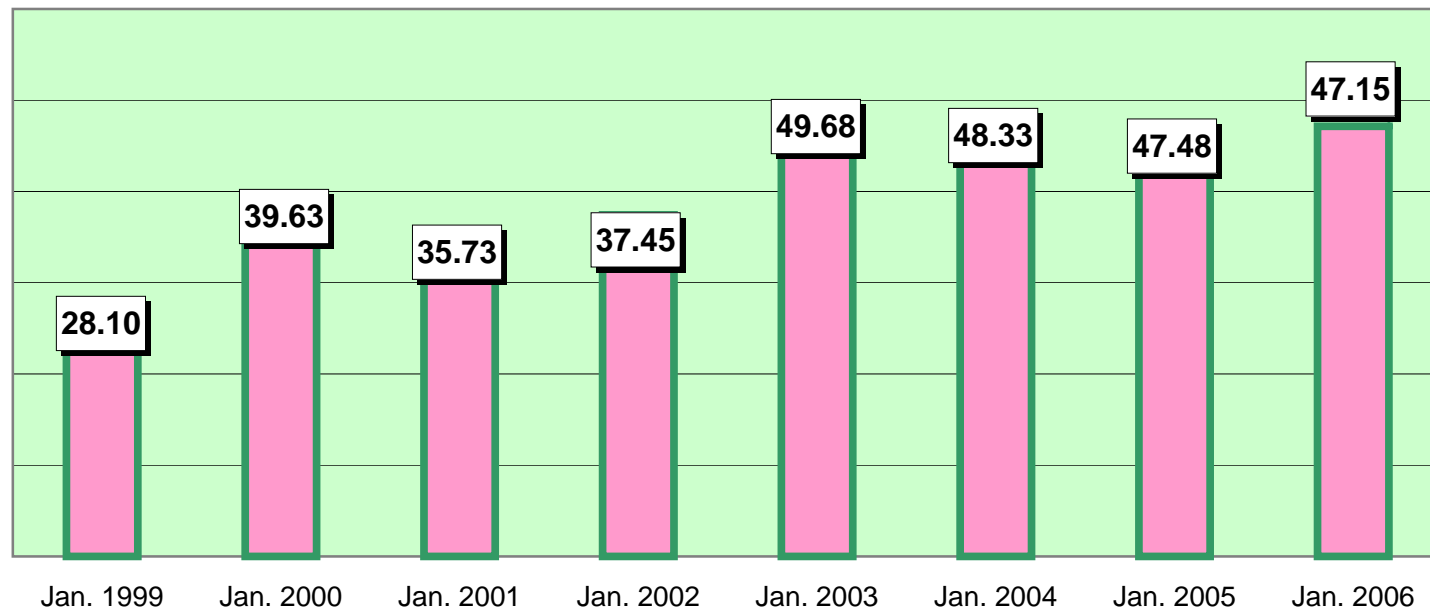

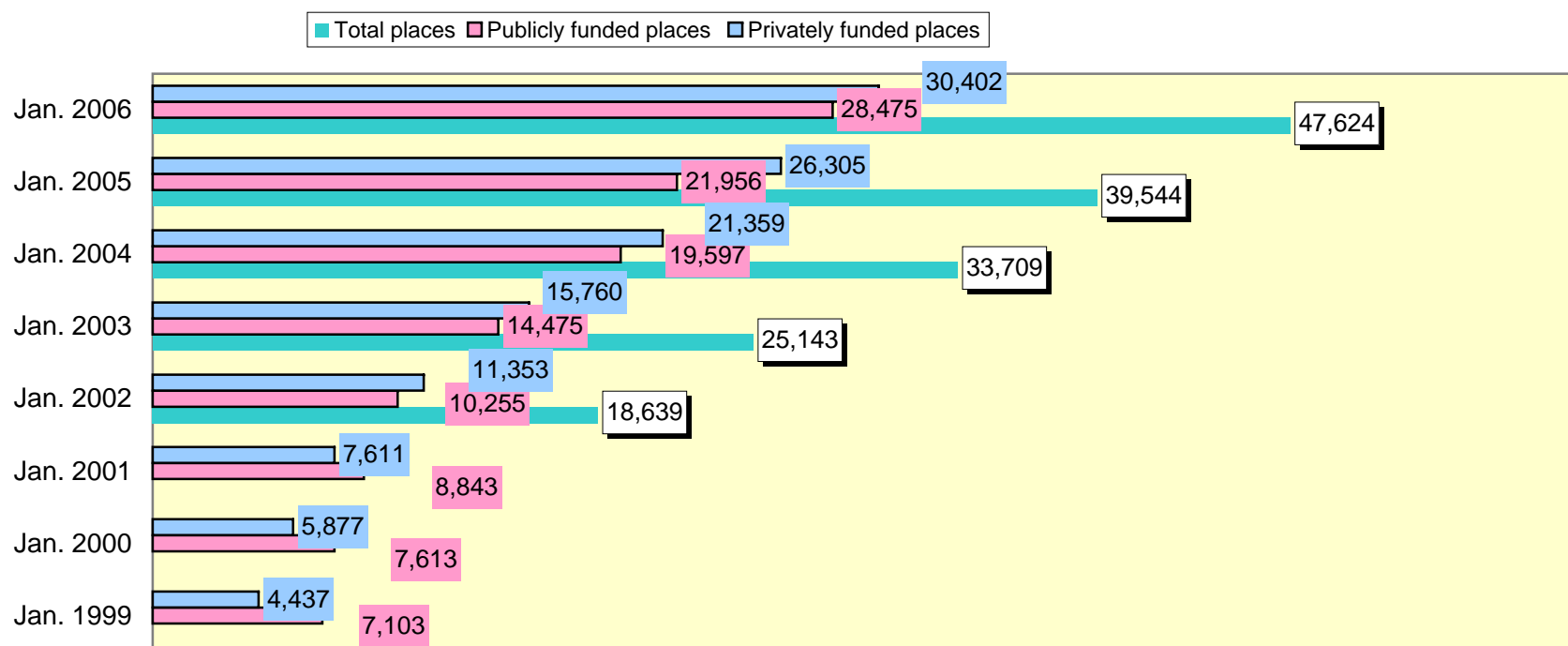

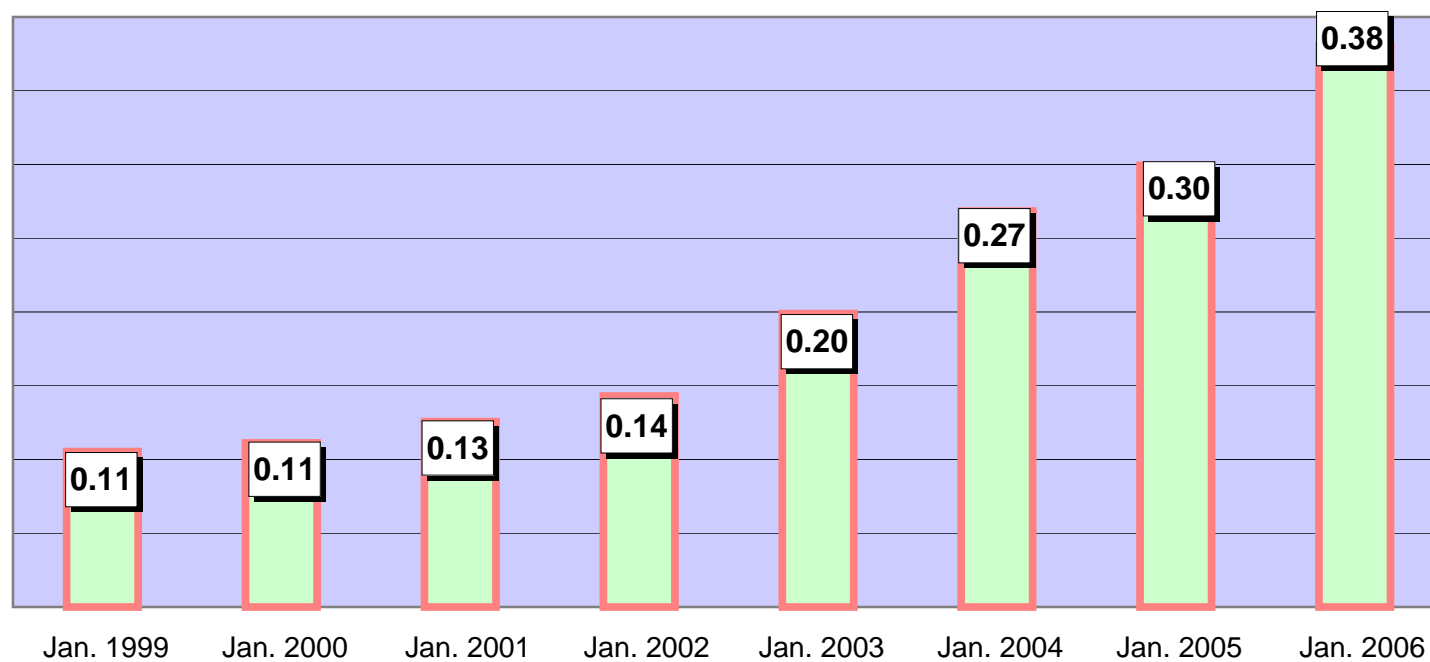

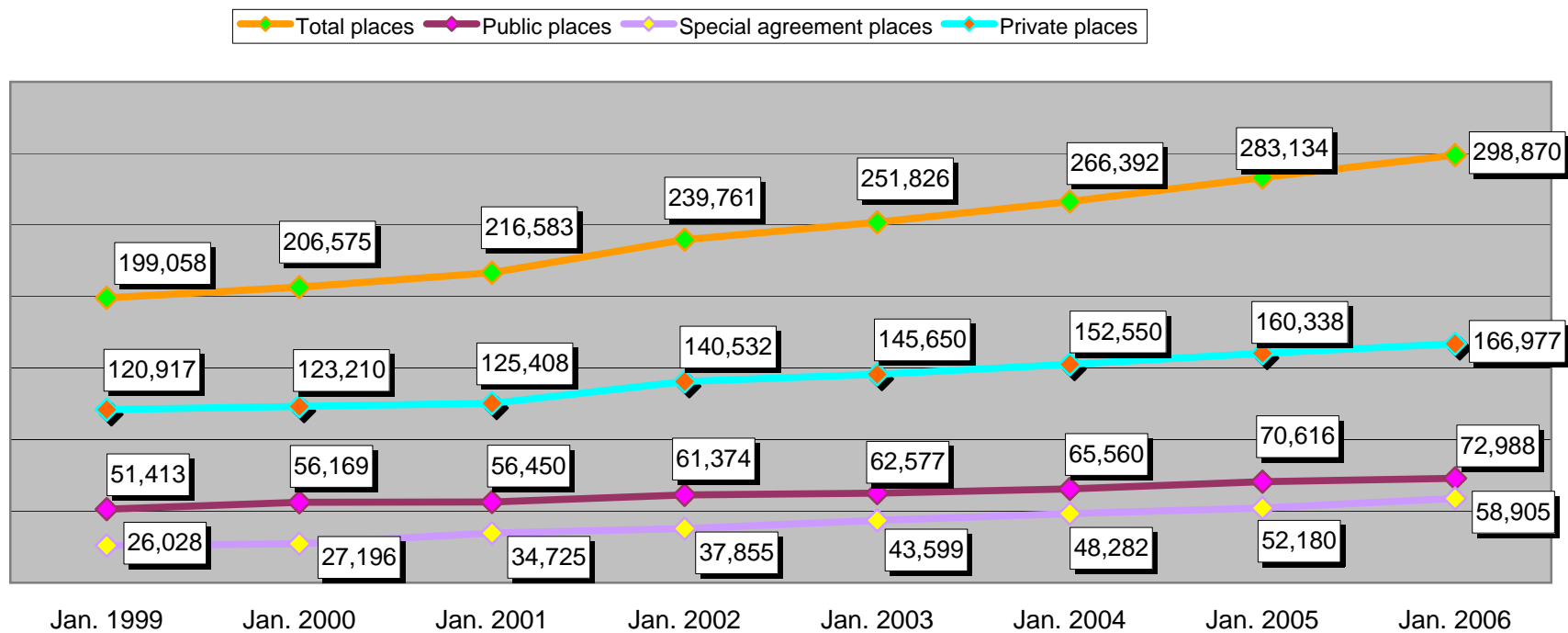

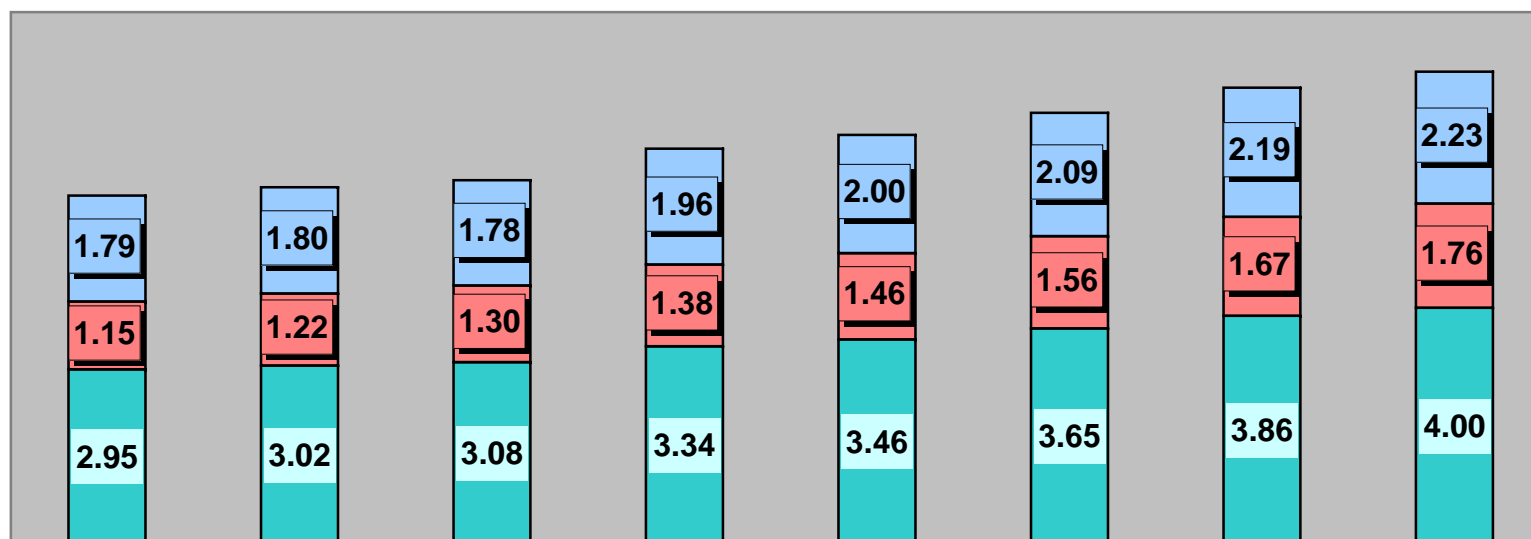
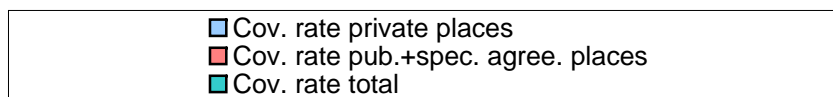

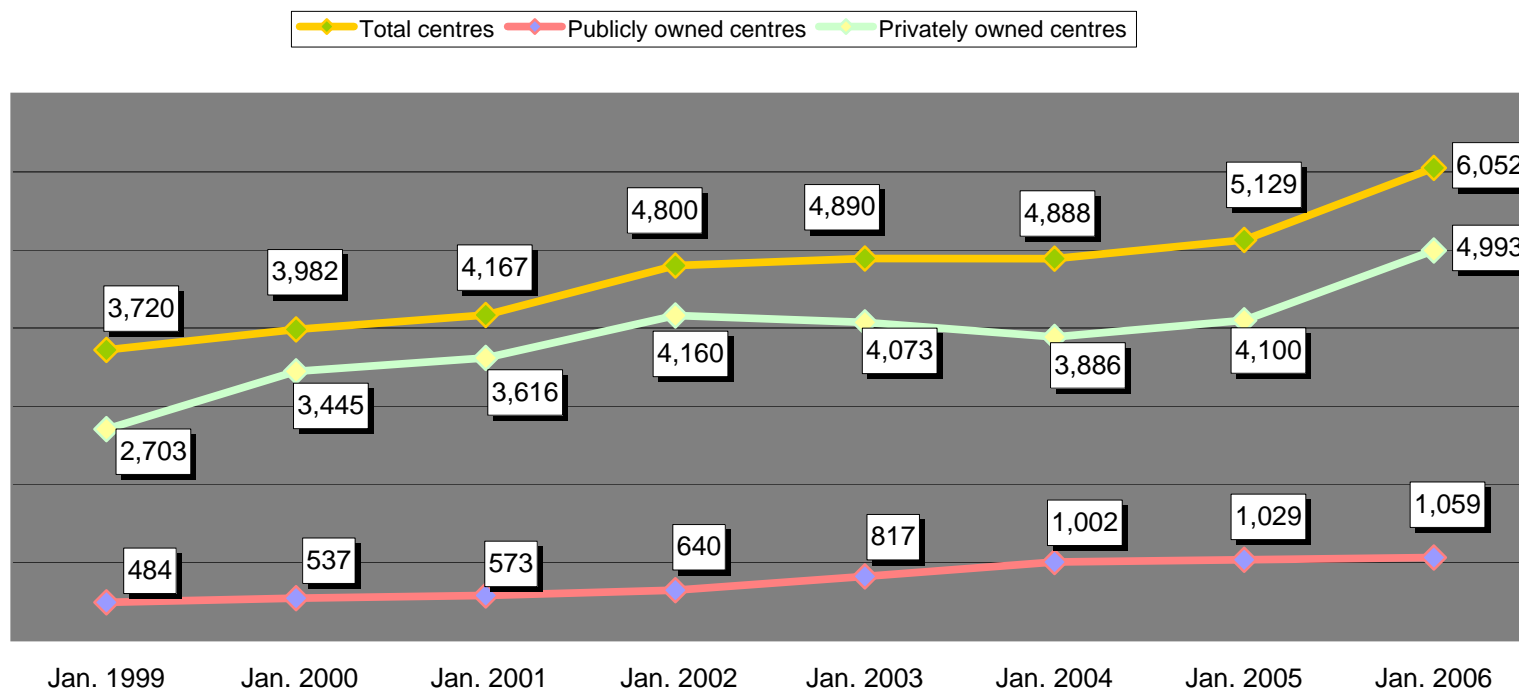

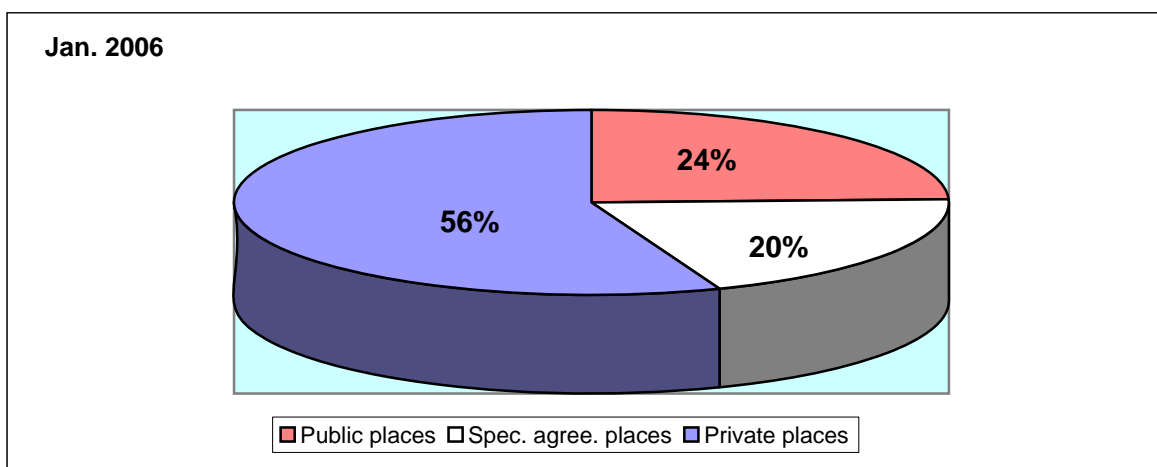
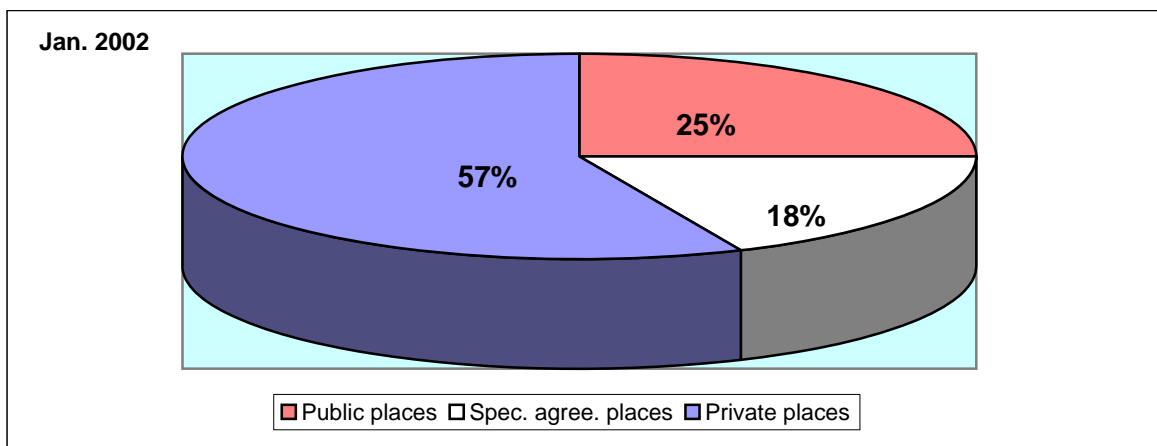
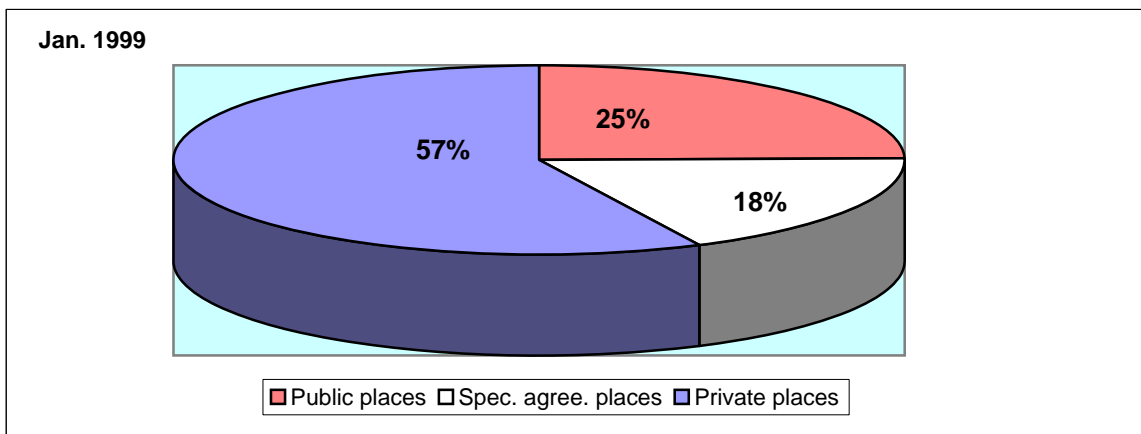

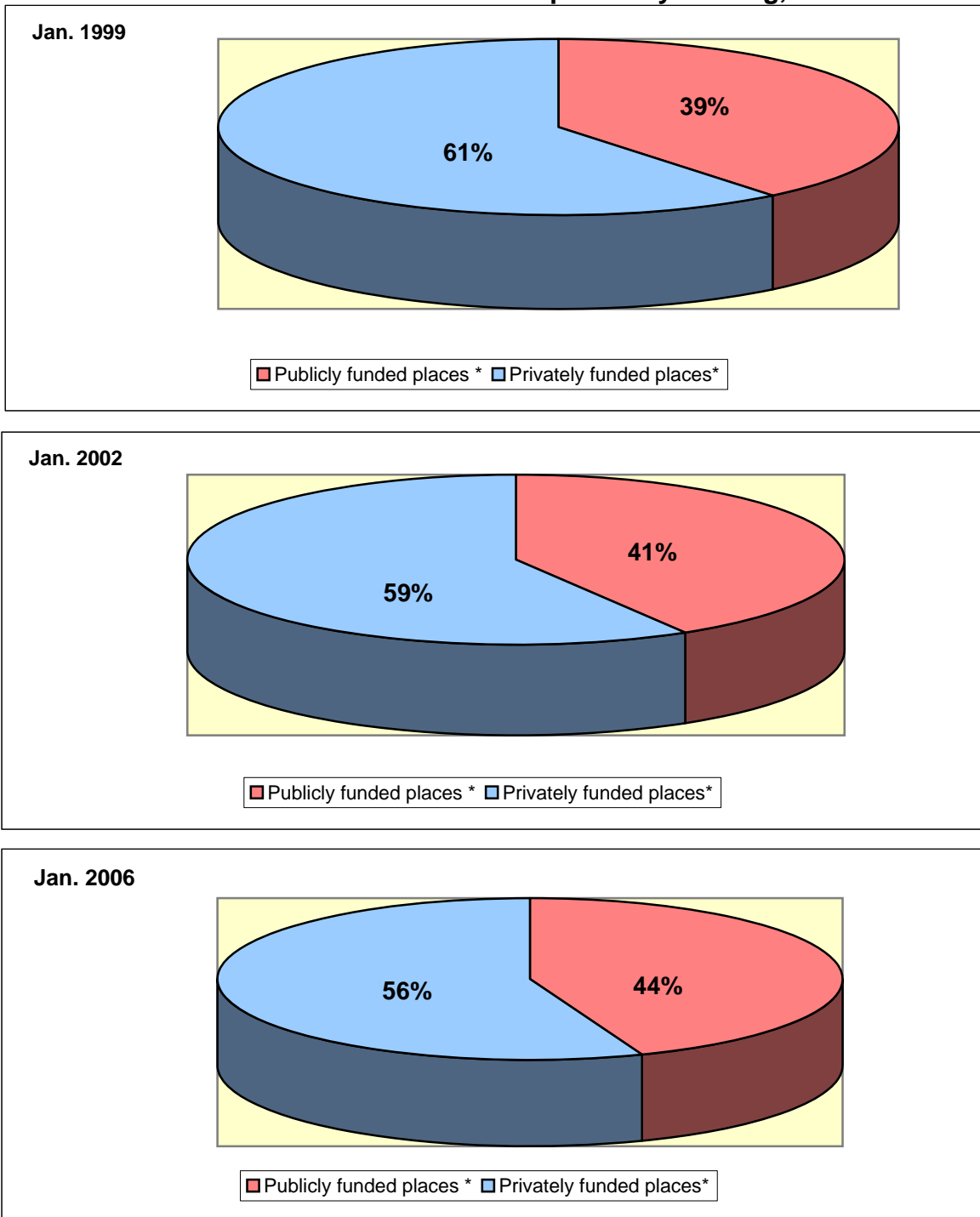

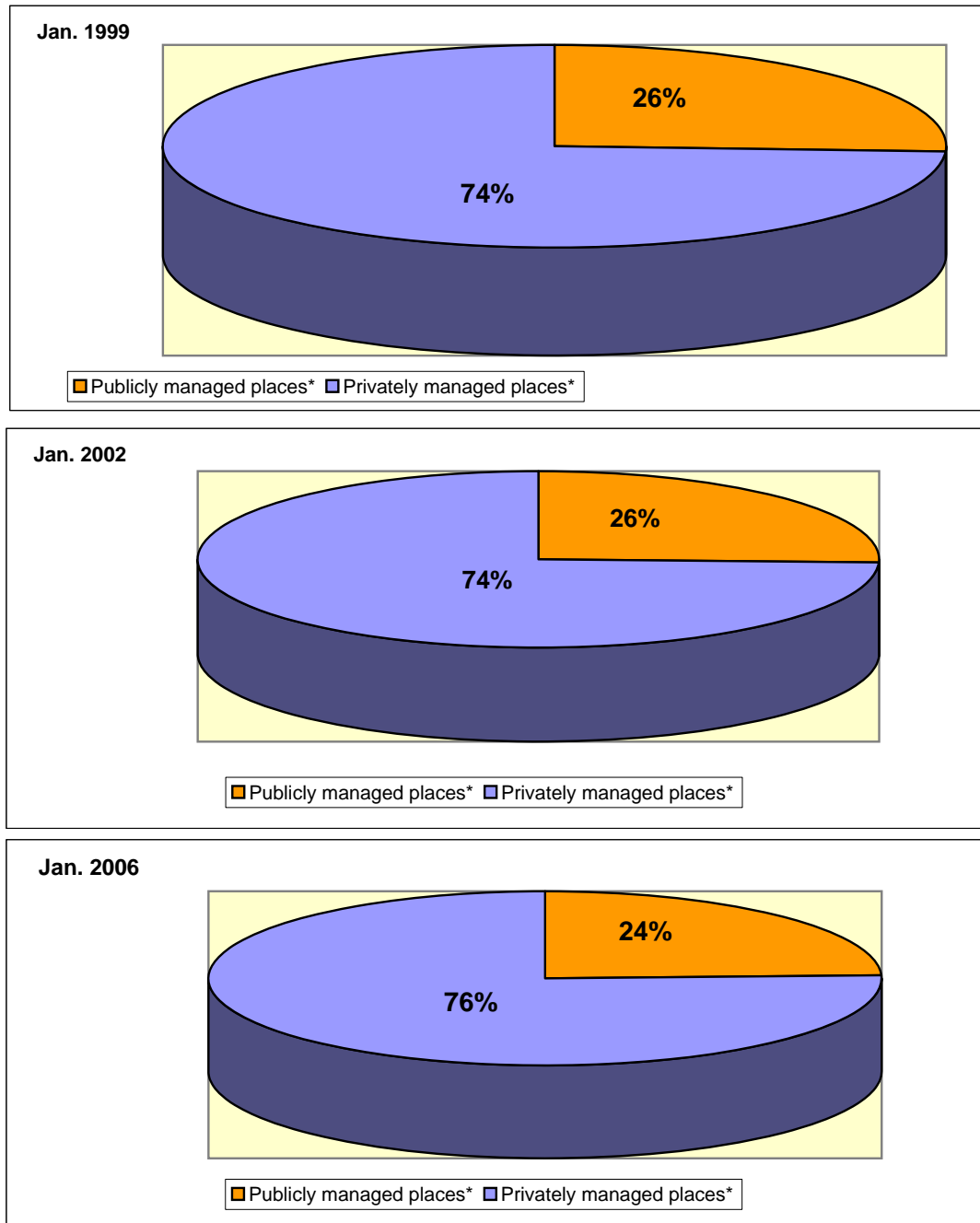

Evolution of the distribution of residential places by management, 1999-2006



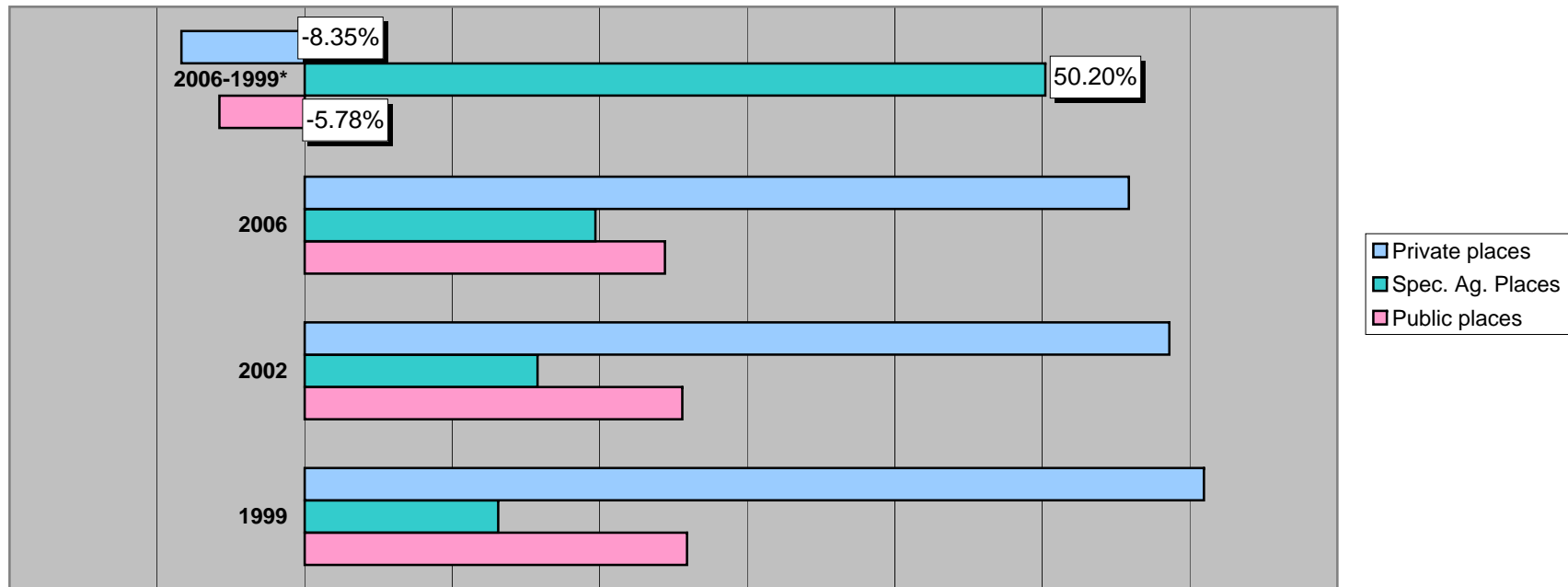
